### PARISH ORDINANCE NO. PO-035-2020

AN ORDINANCE OF THE LAFAYETTE PARISH COUNCIL APPROVING THE ESTABLISHMENT, MAINTENANCE AND OPERATION OF A TEMPORARY BRANCH OFFICE BY THE LAFAYETTE PARISH REGISTRAR OF VOTERS AT THE MARTIN LUTHER KING RECREATION CENTER FOR CONDUCTING EARLY VOTING PURSUANT TO LA. R.S. 18:133, AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE LAFAYETTE MAYOR-PRESIDENT TO ENTER INTO AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH THE CITY OF LAFAYETTE FOR THE FUNDING OF THE TEMPORARY BRANCH OFFICE FOR THE LAFAYETTE PARISH REGISTRAR OF VOTERS AT THE MARTIN LUTHER KING RECREATION CENTER FOR CONDUCTING EARLY VOTING, AND AMENDING THE FY 19/20 OPERATING BUDGET AND CAPITAL BUDGET OF THE LAFAYETTE PARISH CONSOLIDATED GOVERNMENT BY INCREASING REIMBURSEMENT REVENUES TO THE PARISH OF LAFAYETTE FROM THE CITY OF LAFAYETTE TO PROVIDE FUNDING NEEDED FOR SAID TEMPORARY BRANCH OFFICE OF THE LAFAYETTE PARISH REGISTRAR OF VOTERS FOR CONDUCTING EARLY VOTING

BE IT ORDAINED by the Lafayette Parish Council, that:

WHEREAS, La. R.S. 18:133 provides that "the registrar of each parish, with prior approval of the parish governing authority, may establish, maintain and operate additional temporary branch offices for the registration of voters. The location of these offices shall be determined by the registrar"; and

WHEREAS, the Lafayette Parish Council, as the governing authority of the Parish of Lafayette, desires the establishment of a temporary branch office of the Lafayette Parish Registrar of Voters at the Martin Luther King Recreation Center pursuant to La. R.S. 18:133 for the purpose of conducting seven (7) days of early voting to better serve the registered voters of Lafayette Parish during the early voting period; and

WHEREAS, Article VI, Section 20 of the 1974 Constitution of the State of Louisiana states that, "[e]xcept as otherwise provided by law, a political subdivision may exercise and perform any authorized power and function, including financing, jointly or in cooperation with one or more political subdivisions, either within or without the state, or with the United States or its agencies"; and

WHEREAS, Article VII, Section 14(C) of the 1974 Constitution of the State of Louisiana and LSA-R.S. 33:1324, *et seq.* provide that, for a public purpose, public entities, parishes, municipalities and political subdivisions may engage in and make cooperative endeavor agreements/intergovernmental agreements between themselves for specific purposes; and

WHEREAS, La. RS. 18:132(A) further provides for the governing authority of each parish to furnish the office space required for the registrar and to be responsible for the cost of all equipment and supplies, including all furniture, books, stationery, and other expenses for the

operation of the office by the registrar; and

WHEREAS, the City of Lafayette has agreed to defray the costs of establishing, maintaining and operating the temporary branch office of the Lafayette Parish Registrar of Voters at the Martin Luther King Recreation Center; and

WHEREAS, the City of Lafayette and the Parish of Lafayette wish to enter into an Intergovernmental Agreement to set forth the terms and conditions that will govern the funding and all other financial actions to be made with respect to the establishment of a temporary branch office of the Lafayette Parish Registrar of Voters at the Martin Luther King Recreation Center; and

WHEREAS, the Lafayette Parish Council hereby finds and declares that entering into the Intergovernmental Agreement between the Parish of Lafayette and the City of Lafayette concerning the funding for the establishment, maintenance and operation of a temporary branch office for the Lafayette Parish Registrar of Voters at the Martin Luther King Recreation Center for the purpose of conducting early voting serves a public purpose and is in the best interests of the citizens of Lafayette Parish; and

WHEREAS, the Lafayette City-Parish Consolidated Government Home Rule Charter Sections 5-04 and 5-05 provide for amendments to the Operating Budget and Capital Budget by an ordinance adopted by the favorable vote of the majority of the authorized membership of the Lafayette Parish Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED by the Lafayette Parish Council, that:

**SECTION 1:** All of the above "Whereas" clauses in the preamble of this ordinance are hereby adopted as part of this ordinance.

**SECTION 2:** The Lafayette Parish Council hereby authorizes and approves the establishment, maintenance, and operation of a temporary branch office of the Lafayette Parish Registrar of Voters at the Martin Luther King Recreation Center for the purpose of conducting early voting.

SECTION 3: The Lafayette Parish Council hereby authorizes the Lafayette Mayor-President to execute the Intergovernmental Agreement between the Parish of Lafayette and the City of Lafayette concerning the funding for the establishment, maintenance and operation of a temporary branch office for the Lafayette Parish Registrar of Voters at the Martin Luther King Recreation Center for the purpose of conducting early voting, in accordance with the terms, and substantially in the form, attached hereto and made a part hereof by reference, as well as any and

all documents and/or agreements that may be necessary, and to take any other actions that may be necessary in order to complete any of the transactions related to the establishment, maintenance, and operation of a temporary branch office of the Lafayette Parish Registrar of Voters at the Martin Luther King Center for the purpose of conducting early voting.

SECTION 4: The F/Y 19/20 Operating/Capital Budget of the Lafayette City-Parish Consolidated Government is hereby amended by increasing reimbursement revenues to the Parish of Lafayette from the City of Lafayette to provide additional funding needed for the establishment, maintenance, and operation of the temporary branch office of the Lafayette Parish Registrar of Voters, which amendment shall be as reflected in any pertinent documents which are attached hereto and made a part hereof and filed in the Office of the Clerk of the Council.

**SECTION 5:** The Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to affect the required administrative budgetary revisions to the Operating/Capital Budget once all transactions are processed.

**SECTION 6:** Once this ordinance has been adopted, the Legal Department of the Lafayette City-Parish Consolidated Government will submit the ordinance to the Louisiana Secretary of State and the Lafayette Parish Registrar of Voters.

**SECTION 7:** All ordinances or resolutions, or parts thereof, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

**SECTION 8:** This ordinance shall become effective upon signature of the Lafayette Mayor-President, the elapse of ten (10) days after receipt by the Lafayette Mayor-President without signature or veto, or upon an override of a veto, whichever occurs first.

INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE PARISH OF LAFAYETTE AND THE CITY OF LAFAYETTE CONCERNING THE FUNDING FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT, MAINTENANCE AND OPERATION OF A TEMPORARY BRANCH OFFICE FOR THE LAFAYETTE PARISH REGISTRAR OF VOTERS AT THE MARTIN LUTHER KING RECREATION CENTER FOR THE PURPOSE OF CONDUCTING EARLY VOTING FOR THE REGISTERED VOTERS OF LAFAYETTE PARISH

## STATE OF LOUISIANA PARISH OF LAFAYETTE

**BE IT KNOWN**, that on the dates hereinafter set forth, before us, the undersigned authorities, Notaries Public, in and for the aforesaid Parish and State, duly commissioned and qualified as such, and in the presence of the undersigned competent witnesses, personally came and appeared:

who, having been duly sworn, did state and declare, as follows:

WHEREAS, La. R.S. 18:133 provides that "the registrar of each parish, with prior approval of the parish governing authority, may establish, maintain and operate additional temporary branch offices for the registration of voters. The location of these offices shall be determined by the registrar"; and

WHEREAS, the Lafayette Parish Council, as the governing authority of the Parish of Lafayette, desires the establishment of a temporary branch office of the Lafayette Parish Registrar of Voters at the Martin Luther King Recreation Center pursuant to La. R.S. 18:133 for the purpose of conducting seven (7) days of early voting to better serve the registered voters of Lafayette Parish during the early voting period; and

WHEREAS, in order to obtain approval for a temporary branch office for Lafayette, Louisiana, the Louisiana State Department, Office of Secretary of State requires the Lafayette City-Parish Consolidated Government, the Lafayette Parish Registrar of Voters, and the Martin

Luther King Recreation Center to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding to memorialize their agreement as to each party's responsibilities and expenses associated with establishing an additional temporary branch office of the Lafayette Parish Registrar of Voters at the Martin Luther King Recreation Center for conducting early voting for the registered voters in Lafayette Parish; and

WHEREAS, La. RS. 18:132(A) provides for the governing authority of each parish to furnish the office space required for the registrar and to be responsible for the cost of all equipment and supplies, including all furniture, books, stationery, and other expenses for the operation of the office by the registrar; and

WHEREAS, the Parish is responsible for providing funding for the Registrar and the Secretary of State for any equipment, operation, and supply fees necessary for a temporary branch office to conduct early voting as provided in the Memorandum of Understanding; and

WHEREAS, the City has agreed to defray the costs of any equipment, operation, and supply fees necessary for the temporary branch office at the East Regional Library to conduct early voting as provided in the Memorandum of Understanding; and

WHEREAS, Article VI, Section 20 of the 1974 Constitution of the State of Louisiana states that, "[e]xcept as otherwise provided by law, a political subdivision may exercise and perform any authorized power and function, including financing, jointly or in cooperation with one or more political subdivisions, either within or without the state, or with the United States or its agencies"; and

WHEREAS, Article VII, Section 14(C) of the 1974 Constitution of the State of Louisiana and LSA-R.S. 33:1324, et seq. provide that, for a public purpose, public entities, parishes, municipalities and political subdivisions may engage in and make cooperative endeavor agreements/intergovernmental agreements between themselves for specific purposes.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the covenants set forth herein, the Parish and the City do hereby agree and contract, as follows:

1. OBLIGATIONS OF THE PARISH. The Parish shall establish a temporary branch office of the Lafayette Parish Registrar of Voters at the Martin Luther King Recreation Center pursuant to La. R.S. 18:133 for the purpose of conducting early voting to better serve the registered voters of Lafayette Parish during the early voting period. Further, the Parish shall enter into a Memorandum of Understanding with the Louisiana State Department, Office of Secretary

of State, the Lafayette Parish Registrar of Voters, and the Martin Luther King Recreation Center to facilitate the establishment of a temporary branch office.

- 2. OBLIGATIONS OF THE CITY. The City shall promptly and timely provide funding to the Parish for any and all fees and costs necessary for the Martin Luther King Recreation Center temporary branch office to conduct early voting during the term of this Agreement as provided in the current Memorandum of Understanding, which is attached hereto, and any and all subsequent versions of the Memorandum of Understanding which may be entered into by the Louisiana State Department, Office of Secretary of State, the Parish, the Lafayette Parish Registrar of Voters, and the Martin Luther King Recreation Center during the term of this intergovernmental agreement.
- 3. <u>AMENDMENT</u>. This Agreement may be amended from time to time with the consent and approval of the governing authorities of the parties hereto. This Agreement shall be binding upon and shall inure to the benefit of the parties hereto and their successors.
- 4. <u>TERM</u>. The term of this Agreement shall commence upon the signature of all of the parties to the Agreement, and the term of this Agreement shall end on December 31, 2023.
- 5. <u>NON-ASSIGNABILITY</u>. This Agreement is strictly between the Parish and the City, and no party has the right to assign this Agreement or any part hereof to any other party.
- 6. <u>ENTIRE AGREEMENT</u>. This Agreement shall constitute the entire agreement between the parties and shall be effective as of the date that this Agreement is fully executed; all prior agreements between the parties, whether written or oral, are merged into this Agreement and shall have no force and effect with regard to this Agreement.
- 7. <u>NOTICES</u>. All notices called for or contemplated hereunder shall be in writing and shall be given by personal delivery or by certified mail, return receipt requested, postage prepaid and addressed as set forth below:

8. COUNTERPARTS. This Agreement may be executed in one or more counterparts, with each counterpart being deemed an original Agreement, but with all counterparts being considered one Agreement.

- 9. SEVERABILITY. If any term or provision of this Agreement is declared or adjudged to be invalid, illegal, or otherwise unenforceable, then the remaining terms or provisions shall remain in full force and effect.
- 10. <u>SURVIVAL</u>. All obligations to be performed after the term of this Agreement shall survive this Agreement.
