

**CITY ORDINANCE NO. CO-049-2021**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE LAFAYETTE CITY COUNCIL AMENDING THE FY 20/21 OPERATING BUDGET OF THE LAFAYETTE CITY-PARISH CONSOLIDATED GOVERNMENT BY DECREASING ANTICIPATED REVENUES IN THE AMOUNT OF \$149,500.00 IN LAW ENFORCEMENT-BASED SPECIALIST PROGRAM GRANT FUNDS FROM THE OFFICE FOR VICTIMS OF CRIME WITHIN THE LAFAYETTE POLICE DEPARTMENT**

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Lafayette City Council, that:

**WHEREAS**, the Lafayette City-Parish Consolidated Government was awarded a Law Enforcement-Based Specialist Program Grant from the Office for Victims of Crime (OVC) through the U.S. Department of Justice Office of Justice Programs for the implementation of a Lafayette Advocacy for Crime Victims Program; and

**WHEREAS**, the aforementioned award was not accepted, and the award has been closed out with OVC.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED** by the Lafayette City Council, that:

**SECTION 1:** All of the aforescribed “Whereas” clauses are adopted as part of this ordinance.

**SECTION 2:** The FY 20/21 operating budget of the Lafayette City-Parish Consolidated Government is hereby amended by decreasing anticipated revenues in the amount of \$149,500.00 in Law Enforcement-Based Specialist Program funding from the Office of Victims of Crime from the Lafayette Police Department.

**SECTION 3:** This decrease in revenues shall be as reflected in any pertinent documents which are attached hereto and made a part hereof and filed in the Office of the Lafayette Clerk of the Council.

**SECTION 4:** All ordinances or resolutions, or parts thereof, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

**SECTION 5:** This ordinance shall become effective upon signature of the Lafayette Mayor-President, the elapse of ten (10) days after receipt by the Lafayette Mayor-President without signature or veto, or upon an override of a veto, whichever occurs first.
