

PARISH ORDINANCE NO. PO-038-2021

AN ORDINANCE OF THE LAFAYETTE PARISH COUNCIL AMENDING THE FY 20/21 CAPITAL AND OPERATING BUDGETS OF THE LAFAYETTE CITY-PARISH CONSOLIDATED GOVERNMENT BY TRANSFERRING \$1,000,000 FROM CONTRACTUAL SERVICES TO THE OAK SPRINGS FLOOD CONTROL ACCOUNT WITHIN THE PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT FOR ADDITIONAL FUNDING NEEDED

BE IT ORDAINED by the Lafayette Parish Council, that:

SECTION 1: The FY 20/21 capital and operating budgets of the Lafayette City-Parish Consolidated Government is hereby amended by transferring \$1,000,000 from Contractual Services to Oak Springs Flood Control within the Public Works Department for additional funding needed.

SECTION 2: This transfer of funds shall be as reflected in any pertinent documents which are attached hereto and made a part hereof and filed in the office of the Lafayette Clerk of Council.

SECTION 3: All ordinances or resolutions, or parts thereof, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4: This ordinance shall become effective upon signature of the Lafayette Mayor-President, the elapse of ten (10) days after receipt by the Lafayette Mayor-President without signature or veto, or upon an override of a veto, whichever occurs first.






