#### ORDINANCE NO. JO-066-2021

A JOINT ORDINANCE OF THE LAFAYETTE CITY COUNCIL AND THE LAFAYETTE PARISH COUNCIL AUTHORIZING THE FILING OF AN APPLICATION WITH THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY FOR A REGIONAL ASSISTANCE TO FIREFIGHTERS GRANT FOR THE LAFAYETTE FIRE DEPARTMENT AND THE PARISH OF LAFAYETTE

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Lafayette City Council and the Lafayette Parish Council, that:

WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Homeland Security has made funds available for Assistance to Firefighters Grants; and

WHEREAS, the primary purpose of this grant is to meet the firefighting and emergency response needs of fire departments and nonaffiliated emergency medical services organizations; and

WHEREAS, regional projects are designed to facilitate interoperability and efficiency among jurisdictions; and

WHEREAS, at this time the particulars of the grant opportunity have not been released, however, there may be a five percent to twenty percent match requirement for this grant; and

WHEREAS, historically this grant has had a specified period of performance, but it is unknown at this time.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED by the Lafayette City Council and the Lafayette Parish Council, that:

**SECTION 1:** All of the aforedescribed "Whereas" clauses are adopted as part of this ordinance.

SECTION 2: The Lafayette City Council and the Lafayette Parish Council hereby authorize the filing of an application with the U.S. Department of Homeland Security for a regional Assistance to Firefighters Grant for the Lafayette Fire Department and the Parish of Lafayette.

**SECTION 3:** The Lafayette City Council and the Lafayette Parish Council hereby authorize the Lafayette Mayor-President, or his designee, to conduct all negotiations, execute and submit all documents, including but not limited to applications, agreements, cooperative endeavor agreement or contract, amendments, payment requests, completion reports, and so on, which may be necessary for the completion of the aforementioned project.

**SECTION 4:** All ordinances or resolutions, or parts thereof, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 5: After first having been adopted by a majority of the authorized membership of both the Lafayette Parish Council and the Lafayette City Council, this joint

ordinance shall become effective upon signature of this joint ordinance by the Lafayette Mayor-President, the elapse of ten (10) days after receipt by the Lafayette Mayor-President without signature or veto, or upon override of a veto, whichever occurs first.
