AN ORDINANCE OF THE LAFAYETTE CITY COUNCIL AMENDING THE FY 21/22 CAPITAL BUDGET OF THE LAFAYETTE CITY-PARISH CONSOLIDATED GOVERNMENT BY INCREASING ANTICIPATED REVENUES IN THE AMOUNT OF \$905,985 FROM THE FEDERAL TRANSIT ADMINISTRATION (FTA) SECTION 5307 URBANIZED AREA FORMULA GRANT AND APPROPRIATING THESE FUNDS ALONG WITH THE REQUIRED MATCH IN THE AMOUNT OF \$197,233 FOR USE WITHIN THE TRAFFIC, ROADS & BRIDGES DEPARTMENT, TRANSIT DIVISION

BE IT ORDAINED by the Lafayette City Council, that:

SECTION 1: The FY 21/22 capital budget of the Lafayette City-Parish Consolidated Government is hereby amended by increasing anticipated revenues in the amount of \$905,985 from the Federal Transit Administration (FTA) Section 5307 Urbanized Area Formula Grant and appropriating these funds within the Traffic, Roads & Bridges Department, Transit Division.


