#### CITY ORDINANCE NO. CO-161-2021

AN ORDINANCE OF THE LAFAYETTE CITY COUNCIL AMENDING THE FY 21/22 CAPITAL BUDGET OF THE LAFAYETTE CITY-PARISH CONSOLIDATED GOVERNMENT BY INCREASING ANTICIPATED REVENUES IN THE AMOUNT OF \$304,824 FROM THE FEDERAL TRANSIT ADMINISTRATION (FTA) SECTION 5339 BUS AND BUS FACILITIES GRANT ALONG WITH THE REQUIRED MATCH IN THE AMOUNT OF \$53,793 FOR FEDERAL FISCAL YEAR OF 21/22 FOR USE WITHIN THE TRAFFIC, ROADS & BRIDGES DEPARTMENT, TRANSIT DIVISION

BE IT ORDAINED by the Lafayette City Council, that:

SECTION 1: The FY 21/22 capital budget of the Lafayette City-Parish Consolidated Government is hereby amended by increasing anticipated revenues in the amount of \$304,824 from the Federal Transit Administration (FTA) Section 5339 Bus and Bus Facilities Grant, and appropriating these funds within the Traffic, Roads & Bridges Department, Transit Division.


**SECTION 2:** The purpose of the grant is to provide federal funding to replace transit buses within the Traffic, Roads & Bridges Department, Transit Division.

**SECTION 3:** The increase in revenues shall be reflected in any pertinent documents which are attached hereto and made a part hereof and filed in the Office of the Lafayette Clerk of the Council.

**SECTION 4**: All ordinances or resolutions, or parts thereof, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

**SECTION 5:** This ordinance shall become effective upon signature of the Lafayette Mayor-President, the elapse of ten (10) days after receipt by the Lafayette Mayor-President without signature or veto, or upon an override of a veto, whichever occurs first.

This grant will be combined with other grants to fund the purchase of buses under the Lafayette Transit System bus replacement schedule. In service buses having reached a 12-year useful life or 500,000 miles will be retired and replaced by the buses in this grant. The area of operation is the Lafayette Louisiana Urbanized Area. Lafayette is the designated recipient for the Lafayette UZA. The required match is provided by the Lafayette City General Fund.
