

PARISH ORDINANCE NO. PO-009-2022

AN ORDINANCE OF THE LAFAYETTE PARISH COUNCIL AMENDING THE FY 21/22 OPERATING AND CAPITAL BUDGET OF THE LAFAYETTE CITY-PARISH CONSOLIDATED GOVERNMENT BY INCREASING THE USE OF FUND BALANCE IN FUND 261 (DRAINAGE MAINTENANCE FUND) IN THE AMOUNT OF \$1,400,000 AND APPROPRIATING WITHIN THE PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT, CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS DIVISION FOR THE OAK SPRINGS FLOOD CONTROL PROJECT

BE IT ORDAINED by the Lafayette Parish Council, that:

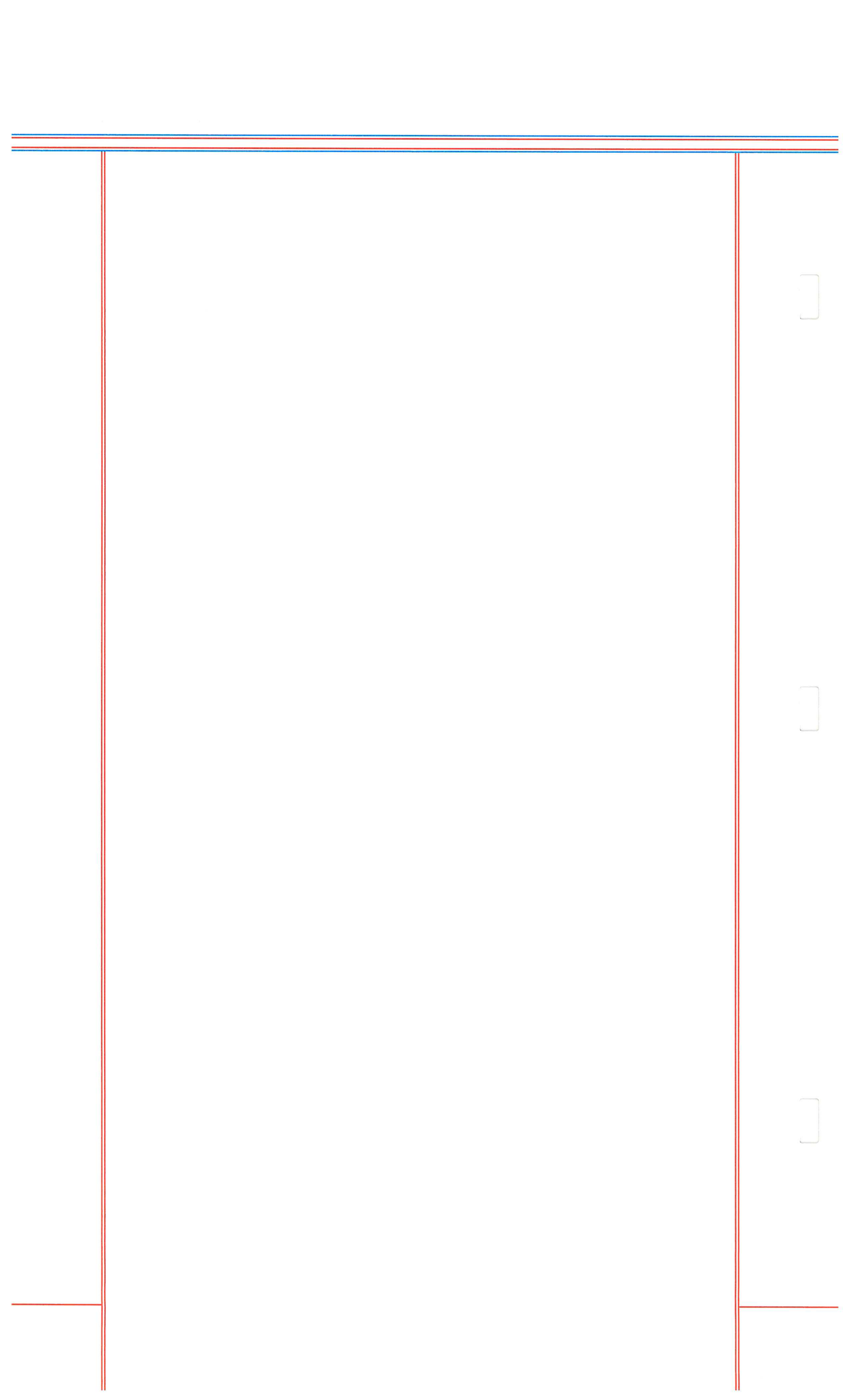
SECTION 1: The FY 21/22 operating and capital budget of the Lafayette City-Parish Consolidated Government are hereby amended by increasing the use of fund balance in Fund 261 (Drainage Maintenance Fund) in the amount of \$1,400,000 and appropriating within the Public Works Department, Capital Improvements Division for the Oak Springs Flood Control project.

SECTION 2: This transfer of funds shall be as reflected in any pertinent documents which are attached hereto and made a part hereof and filed in the Office of the Lafayette Clerk of the Council.

SECTION 3: All ordinances or resolutions, or parts thereof, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4: This ordinance shall become effective upon signature of the Lafayette Mayor-President, the elapse of ten (10) days after receipt by the Lafayette Mayor-President without signature or veto, or upon an override of a veto, whichever occurs first.




