

CITY ORDINANCE NO. CO-020-2022

AN ORDINANCE OF THE LAFAYETTE CITY COUNCIL AMENDING THE FY 21/22 CAPITAL BUDGET OF THE LAFAYETTE CITY-PARISH CONSOLIDATED GOVERNMENT BY TRANSFERRING \$200,000 IN EXCESS FUNDS FROM THE CIDC, LATERAL 7-CURRAN/DULLES PROJECT TO A PROJECT MANAGEMENT SERVICES LINE ITEM WITHIN THE PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT, CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS DIVISION

BE IT ORDAINED by the Lafayette City Council, that:

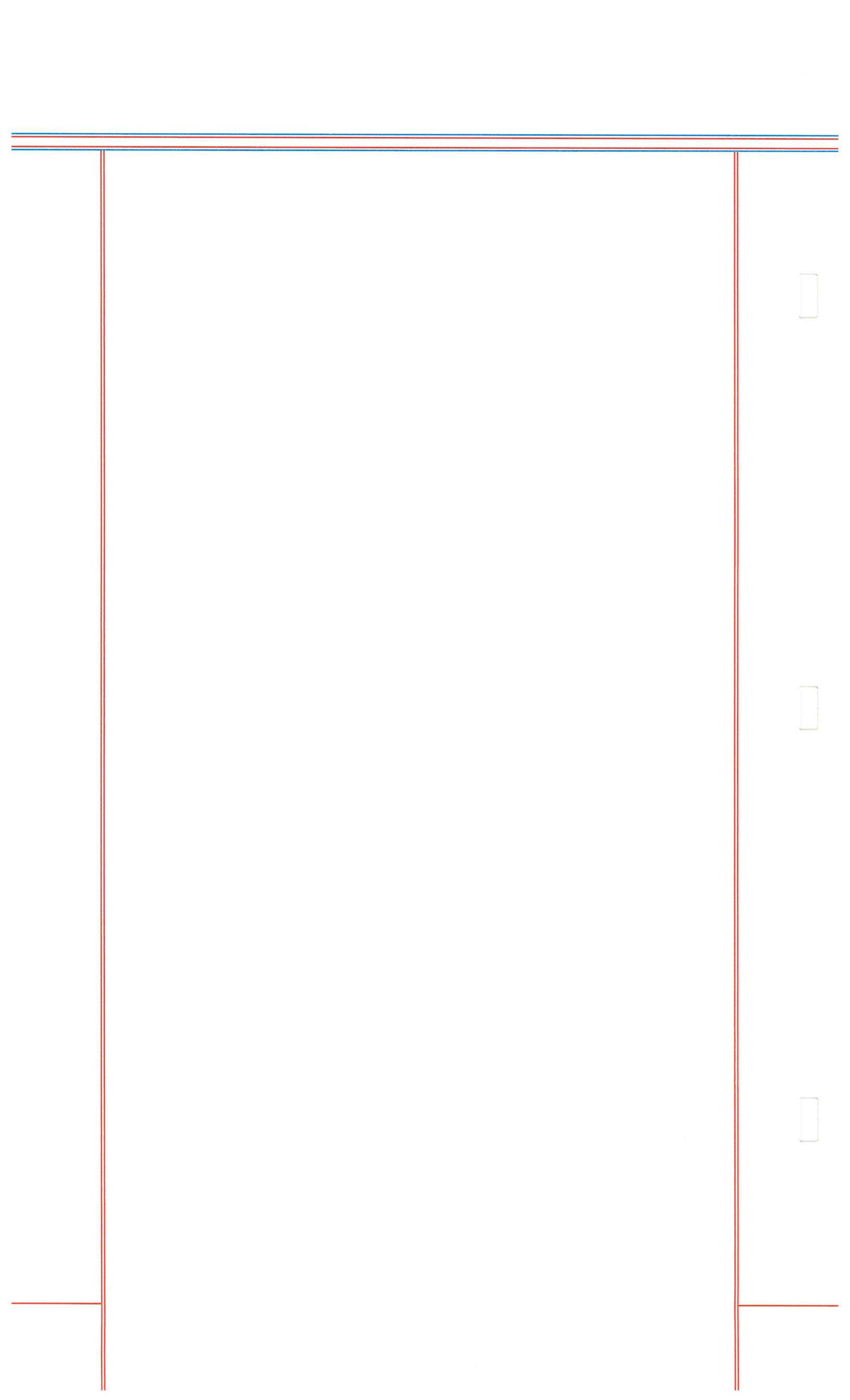
SECTION 1: The FY 21/22 capital budget of the Lafayette City-Parish Consolidated Government is hereby amended by transferring \$200,000 in excess funds from the CIDC, Lateral 7-Curran/Dulles project to a Project Management Services line item within the Public Works Department, Capital Improvements Division.

SECTION 2: This transfer of funds shall be as reflected in any pertinent documents which are attached hereto and made a part hereof and filed in the Office of the Lafayette Clerk of the Council.

SECTION 3: All ordinances or resolutions, or parts thereof, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4: This ordinance shall become effective upon signature of the Lafayette Mayor-President, the elapse of ten (10) days after receipt by the Lafayette Mayor-President without signature or veto, or upon an override of a veto, whichever occurs first.




