PO-052-2021 AMENDING THE FY 21/22 OPERATING AND CAPITAL BUDGET OF THE LAFAYETTE CITY-PARISH CONSOLIDATED GOVERNMENT BY DECREASING COUNCIL RESERVES IN FUND 651 AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN/21-PARISH FUND IN THE AMOUNT OF \$2,975,000 AND APPROPRIATING WITHIN THE VOLUNTEER FIRE DEPARTMENTS FOR VOLUNTEER FIRE DEPARTMENT TANKER TRUCKS (7)

BE IT ORDAINED by the Lafayette Parish Council, that:

SECTION 1: Parish Ordinance No. PO-052-2021 is hereby amended by amending the FY 21/22 operating and capital budget of the Lafayette City-Parish Consolidated Government by decreasing Council Reserves in Fund 651 American Rescue Plan/21-Parish Fund in the amount of \$2,975,000 and appropriating within the Volunteer Fire Departments for Volunteer Fire Department Tanker Trucks (7).

SECTION 2: This transfer of funds shall be contingent upon the Lafayette City-Parish Consolidated Government's adherence to all applicable Federal laws, including 2 CFR 200, and all regulations assigned by the U.S. Department of the Treasury in connection with the American Rescue Plan Act.

**SECTION 3:** This project is classified as Expenditure Category 6.1 – Provision of Government Services as required in the U.S. Treasury's Compliance and Reporting Guidance.


