WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Justice has funding available for Law Enforcement

WHEREAS, these funds will be used by the Lafayette Police Department to develop and implement a mental wellness program for officers; and

WHEREAS, upon completion of all required documents and meeting all special conditions of the program, the Lafayette Police Department will be notified of the final approval of funds; and

WHEREAS, upon notification of final approval and award of funds, the Lafayette Mayor-President as the authorized signing official will complete the award acceptance documentation including signature; and the Lafayette Police Department will submit the required budgetary revision to the Lafayette City Council for approval prior to expenditure of any grant funds.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Lafayette City Council, that:

SECTION 1: All of the aforedescribed "Whereas" clauses are adopted as part of this resolution.

SECTION 2: The Lafayette City Council hereby authorizes the filing of an application with the U.S. Department of Justice

SECTION 3: The Lafayette City Council hereby authorizes the Lafayette Mayor-President, or his designee, to conduct all negotiations, execute and submit all documents, including but not limited to applications, agreements, amendments, payment requests and so on, which may be necessary for the completion of the aforementioned project.

SECTION 4: All resolutions or parts thereof, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
