

**CITY ORDINANCE NO. CO-052-2022**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE LAFAYETTE CITY COUNCIL AMENDING THE  
PERFORMANCE RENTAL RATES FOR THE USE OF THE HEYMANN  
PERFORMING ARTS CENTER CONTAINED WITHIN THE FEE SCHEDULE  
ORIGINALLY SET FORTH AND ADOPTED IN ORDINANCE  
NO. O-117-2000 AND LATER AMENDED BY ORDINANCE NO. O-053-2010**

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Lafayette City Council, that:

**WHEREAS**, the City of Lafayette owns the Heymann Performing Arts Center and the Frem F. Boustany Convention Center (including the parking lots adjacent to the Heymann Center which was the former Center Cinema property and the Lafayette Science Museum); and

**WHEREAS**, on March 23, 2010, the Lafayette City-Parish Council adopted Ordinance No. O-053-2010 to, among other things, amend the rental fee schedule for the use of the Heymann Performing Arts Center and the Frem F. Boustany Convention Center; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Lafayette desires to amend the performance rental rates in the attached fee schedule as it relates to the Heymann Performing Arts Center from a “per performance” rental rate to a “per day” rental rate, to better incentivize presenters to host multiple showings at the Heymann Center in one day, such being consistent with the current industry norm.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED** by the Lafayette City Council, that:

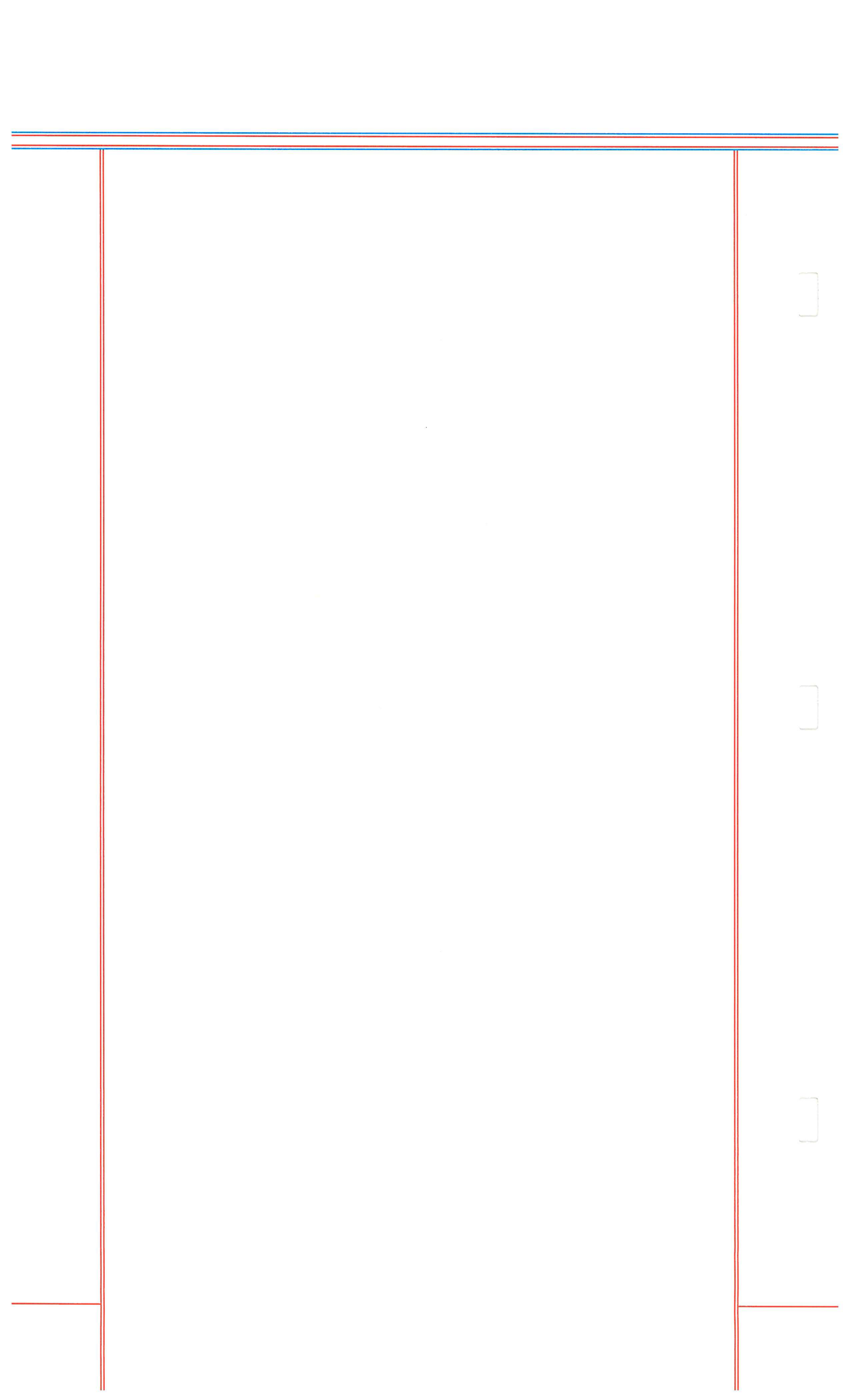
**SECTION 1:** All of the aforementioned “Whereas” clauses in the preamble of this Ordinance are adopted as part of this Ordinance.

**SECTION 2:** The City of Lafayette hereby amends the performance rental rates in the attached fee schedule as it relates to the Heymann Performing Arts Center from a “per performance” rental rate to a “per day” rental rate, as more fully shown and set forth in the attached fee schedule.

**SECTION 3:** All ordinances or resolutions, or parts thereof, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

**SECTION 4:** This ordinance shall become effective upon signature of the Lafayette Mayor-President, the elapse of ten (10) days after receipt by the Lafayette Mayor-President without signature or veto, or upon an override of a veto, whichever occurs first.




