

PARISH ORDINANCE NO. PO-018-2022

AN ORDINANCE OF THE LAFAYETTE PARISH COUNCIL AMENDING THE FY 21/22 CAPITAL BUDGET OF THE LAFAYETTE CITY-PARISH CONSOLIDATED GOVERNMENT BY DECREASING COUNCIL RESERVES IN FUND 651 AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN/21-PARISH FUND IN THE AMOUNT OF \$10,000,000.00 AND TRANSFERRING FUND 275 EXISTING FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$1,374,000.00 FROM THE COULEE GRANGES/CIDC FLOOD CONTROL PROJECT AND TRANSFERRING FUND 651 EXISTING FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$1,500,000.00 FROM THE ROBLEY DR DETENTION POND PROJECT AND APPROPRIATING ALL WITHIN THE PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT FOR THE BAYOU VERMILION FLOOD CONTROL PROJECT

BE IT ORDAINED by the Lafayette Parish Council, that:

SECTION 1: The FY 21/22 capital budget of the Lafayette City-Parish Consolidated Government is hereby amended by decreasing Council Reserves in Fund 651 American Rescue Plan/21-Parish Fund in the amount of \$10,000,000.00 and transferring fund 275 existing funds in the amount of \$1,374,000.00 from Coulee Granges/CIDC Flood Control Project and transferring fund 651 existing funds in the amount of \$1,500,000.00 from the Robley Dr Detention Pond Project and appropriating all within the Public Works Department for the Bayou Vermilion Flood Control Project.

SECTION 2: This transfer of funds shall be contingent upon the Lafayette City-Parish Consolidated Government's adherence to all applicable Federal laws, including 2 CFR 200, and all regulations assigned by the U.S. Department of the Treasury in connection with the American Rescue Plan Act.

SECTION 3: This project is classified as Expenditure Category 5.6 – Clean Water: Stormwater as required in the U.S. Treasury's Compliance and Reporting Guidance.

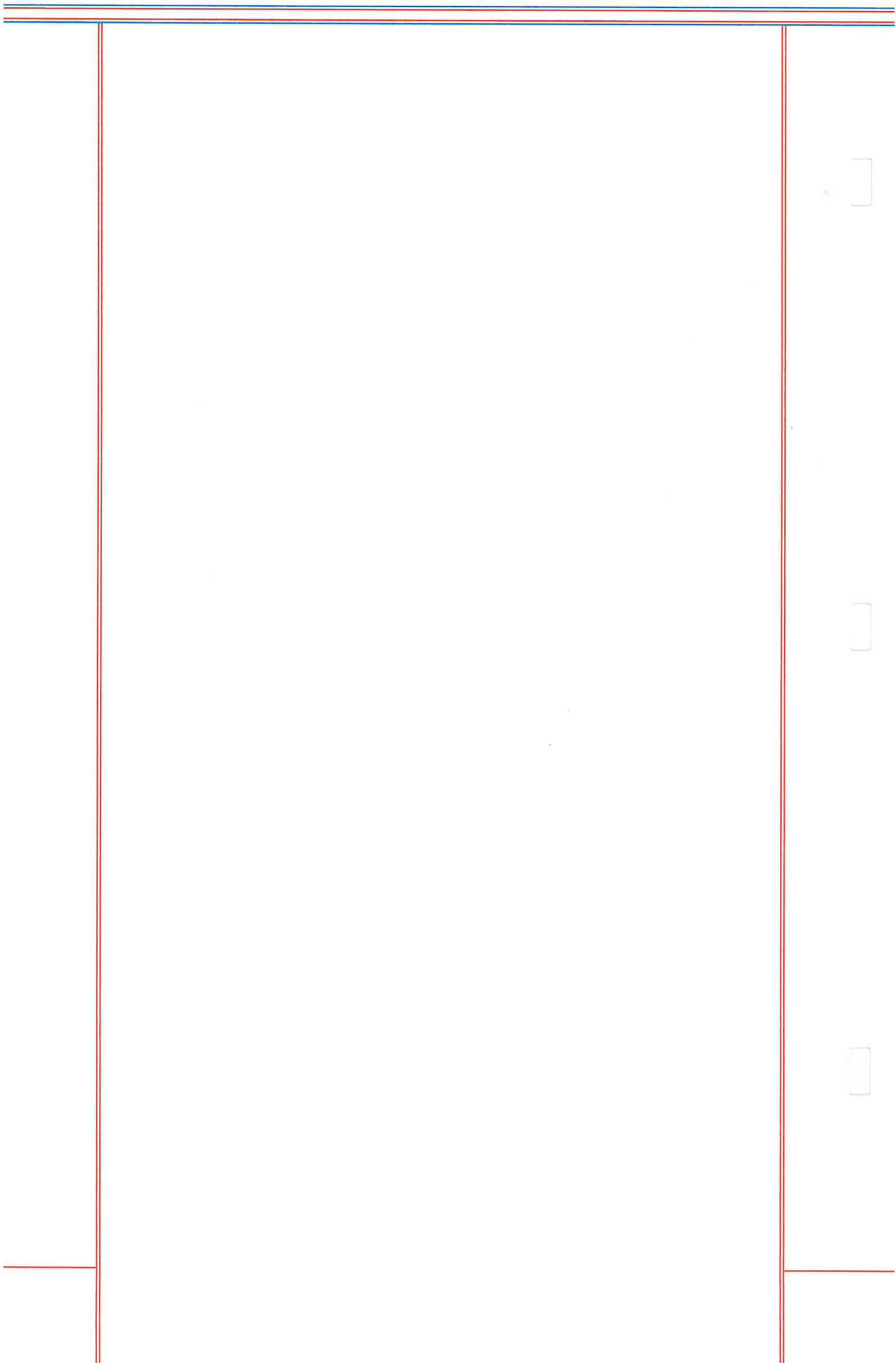
SECTION 4: The Lafayette Parish Council does hereby authorize the Lafayette Mayor-President, or his designee, to conduct all negotiations, execute and submit all documents including, but not limited to, applications, agreements, amendments, payment requests, memoranda of understanding and so on, which may be necessary for the completion of the aforementioned project.

SECTION 5: This transfer of funds shall be as reflected in any pertinent documents which are attached hereto and made a part hereof and filed in the Council Clerk's Office.

SECTION 6: All ordinances or resolutions, or parts thereof, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 7: This ordinance shall become effective upon signature of the Lafayette Mayor-President, the elapse of ten (10) days after receipt by the Lafayette Mayor-President without signature or veto, or upon an override of a veto, whichever occurs first.

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Justification: To appropriate \$10,000,000.00 in American Rescue Plan Act 651 funds from Parish Council Reserves for a project within the Public Works Department for Bayou Vermilion Flood Control and to transfer \$1,500,000.00 in existing 651 funds from the Robley Dr Detention Pond Project and to transfer existing 275 funds from the Coudrie Granges/CDC Flood Control project to the Bayou Vermilion Flood Control project for additional funding needed.


