CITY ORDINANCE NO. CO-158-2022

AN ORDINANCE OF THE LAFAYETTE CITY COUNCIL AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR-PRESIDENT TO EXECUTE THE FIRST AMENDMENT TO THE SECOND INTERGOVERNMENTAL CONTRACT BETWEEN LAFAYETTE CITY-PARISH CONSOLIDATED GOVERNMENT AND THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS FOR THE UNIVERSITY OF LOUISIANA SYSTEM ON BEHALF OF THE UNIVERSITY OF LOUISIANA AT LAFAYETTE

BE IT ORDAINED by the Lafayette City Council, acting as the governing authority for the City of Lafayette, that:

WHEREAS, Lafayette City-Parish Consolidated Government (the "City") and the Board of Supervisors for the University of Louisiana System on behalf of the University of Louisiana at Lafayette ("UL Lafayette") entered into a Second Intergovernmental Contract with an effective date of September 23, 2012 concerning the control and operations of the Cajundome in accordance with Act 230 of the 1979 Regular Session of the Louisiana Legislature; and

WHEREAS, the City and UL Lafayette entered into a Renewal of Term of Governmental Contract that renewed the term of the Second Intergovernmental Contract for an additional five-year term, expiring on October 31, 2022; and

WHEREAS, the City and UL Lafayette desire to amend the Second Intergovernmental Contract to extend its term for six (6) months, until April 30, 2023.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED by the Lafayette City Council, that:

SECTION 1: All of the aforedescribed "Whereas" clauses are adopted as part of this ordinance.

SECTION 2: The Lafayette Mayor-President, or his designee, is hereby authorized to execute the First Amendment to the Second Intergovernmental Contract in the same or substantially similar form as the draft attached hereto, provided that the First Amendment to the Second Intergovernmental Contract shall provide that during the term of the six-month extension, the financial obligations of the City shall be 50% of those stated in the Second Intergovernmental Contract.

SECTION 3: The Lafayette Mayor-President, or his designee, is hereby further authorized to conduct all negotiations and to make, execute, and submit all documents and to perform all actions that may be appropriate to fulfill the agreement conditions.

SECTION 4: All ordinances or resolutions, or parts thereof, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 5: This ordinance shall become effective upon signature of the Lafayette Mayor-President, the elapse of ten (10) days after receipt by the Lafayette Mayor-President without signature or veto, or upon an override of a veto, whichever occurs first.

FIRST AMENDMENT TO SECOND INTERGOVERNMENTAL CONTRACT

BE IT KNOWN, that, on the dates hereinafter set forth, before us, the undersigned authorities, Notaries Public, in and for the aforesaid Parish and State, duly commissioned and qualified as such and in the presence of the undersigned competent witnesses, respectfully came and appeared:

THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS FOR THE UNIVERSITY OF LOUISIANA SYSTEM on behalf of the UNIVERSITY OF LOUISIANA AT LAFAYETTE, herein represented by its President, Dr. E. Joseph Savoie, in accordance with the authority granted pursuant to Act 230 of the 1979 Regular Session of the Louisiana Legislature, which is incorporated herein by reference thereto ("<u>UL Lafayette</u>"), and

THE LAFAYETTE CITY-PARISH CONSOLIDATED GOVERNMENT, herein represented by its Mayor-President, Joshua S. Guillory, in accordance with Ordinance No. CO-____-2022 of the Lafayette City Council, duly adopted on the ____ day of _____, 2022, which is incorporated herein by reference thereto ("City"),

who declared:

WHEREAS, UL Lafayette and the City entered into an Intergovernmental Contract dated September 23, 1987, as amended March 5, 1992, concerning the control and operations of the Cajundome, in accordance with Act 230 of the 1979 Regular Session of the Louisiana Legislature (the "First Intergovernmental Contract"); and

WHEREAS, UL Lafayette and the City entered into a subsequent Second Intergovernmental Contract dated September 23, 2012, concerning the control and operations of the Cajundome, which replaced and superseded the First Intergovernmental Contract (the "Second Intergovernmental Contract"); and

WHEREAS, UL Lafayette and the City entered into a Renewal of Term of Governmental Contract, whereby the Second Intergovernmental Contract was renewed for an additional five-year term, expiring on October 31, 2022; and

WHEREAS, the parties desire to enter into this First Amendment to Second Intergovernmental Contract for the purpose of extending the term of the Second Intergovernmental Contract for six (6) months, until April 30, 2023; and

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants and agreements herein contained, UL Lafayette and the City do hereby agree to amend the Second Intergovernmental Contract upon the following terms and conditions:

The text of Section XXII is hereby deleted and substituted with the following:

The parties hereby agree that this Second Intergovernmental Contract shall be effective as of September 23, 2012 (the "<u>Effective Date</u>") and, unless otherwise provided herein, shall supersede all other agreements by and between the parties concerning the Cajundome. The term of this Second Intergovernmental Contract shall continue from the Effective Date until April 30, 2023, unless otherwise terminated in accordance with this Second Governmental Contract.

Except as specifically modified herein, all other terms, covenants, and conditions of the Second Intergovernmental Contract shall continue in full force and effect.

Attached for consideration by the Lafayette City Council is a proposed ordinance authorizing the Mayor-President to Execute the First Amendment to the Second Intergovernmental Contract (the "Amendment") Between LCG and the Board of Supervisors for the University of Louisiana System on behalf of the University of Louisiana at Lafayette ("UL Lafayette").

The City of Lafayette and UL Lafayette entered into an Intergovernmental Contract dated September 23, 1987, as amended March 5, 1992 (the "First Intergovernmental Contract"), which governed the control and operations of the Cajundome and also created the Cajundome Commission.

The City and UL Lafayette subsequently entered into a successor Second Intergovernmental Contract dated September 23, 2017 (the "Second Intergovernmental Contract"), which replaced and superseded the First Intergovernmental Contract. The initial term of the Second Intergovernmental Contract ended on October 31, 2017. However, Section XXII of the Second Intergovernmental Contract allowed for the contract to be renewed for an additional five (5) year term.

The City and UL Lafayette executed the Renewal of Term of Governmental Contract on November 1, 2017 whereby the Second Intergovernmental Contract was renewed for an additional five-year term, expiring on October 31, 2022.

The attached Amendment extends the term of the Second Intergovernmental Agreement for six (6) months, until April 30, 2023, under its current terms and conditions.

If you approve, please place this on the City Council agenda to be introduced on October 4, 2022 and final on October 18, 2022.
