CITY ORDINANCE NO. CO-159-2022

AN ORDINANCE OF THE LAFAYETTE CITY COUNCIL AMENDING THE FY 21/22 OPERATING BUDGET OF THE LAFAYETTE CITY-PARISH CONSOLIDATED GOVERNMENT BY INCREASING REVENUES IN THE AMOUNT OF \$163,248.00 RECEIVED FROM LOUISIANA HIGHWAY SAFETY COMMISSION AND APPROPRIATING WITHIN THE LAFAYETTE POLICE DEPARTMENT

BE IT ORDAINED by the Lafayette City Council, that:

SECTION 1: The FY 21/22 operating budget of the Lafayette City Consolidated Government is hereby amended by increasing revenues in the amount of \$163,248.00 received from Louisiana Highway Safety Commission and appropriating within the Lafayette Police Department.

SECTION 2: The purpose of this grant is to provide local law enforcement agencies with critical funding necessary to reduce the number of fatal and injury crashes in Louisiana through Seat Belt Checks and OWI Checkpoints manned by Lafayette Police Officers.

SECTION 3: There is no matching requirement for this grant.


SECTION 4: The Lafayette City Council hereby authorizes the Lafayette Mayor-President, or his designee, to conduct all negotiations, execute and submit all documents, including but not limited to applications, agreements, amendments, payment requests and so on, which may be necessary for the completion of the aforementioned project.

SECTION 5: This increase in revenues shall be as reflected in any pertinent documents which are attached hereto and made a part hereof and filed in the Office of the Lafayette Clerk of the Council.

SECTION 6: All ordinances or resolutions, or parts thereof, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 7: This orcinance shall become effective upon signature of the Lafayette Mayor-President, the elapse of ten (10) days after receipt by the Lafayette Mayor-President without signature or veto, or upon an override of a veto, whichever occurs first.
