# A RESOLUTION OF THE LAFAYETTE CITY COUNCIL AFFIRMING THE SELECTION OF FUNDING RECIPIENTS FOR THE 2022-2023 EXTERNAL AGENCIES FUNDING PROGRAM

BE IT RESOLVED by the Lafayette City Council, that:

WHEREAS, the Lafayette City Council has acknowledged that, among the public purposes and functions of a consolidated government under the laws of the State of Louisiana, is the function to provide services which aid in enhancing the economic, social, educational and cultural welfare of the citizens of the jurisdiction of the Lafayette City-Parish Consolidated Government; and

WHEREAS, it is recognized and accepted that there exists within the City of Lafayette certain public and private non-profit agencies and organizations (hereinafter referred to as "external agencies"), which, because of demonstrated expertise, experience, and organizational structure, provide certain services to citizenry in a manner deemed to be more effective and efficient than would be possible by the Lafayette City-Parish Consolidated Government; and

WHEREAS, the Lafayette City-Parish Council adopted Ordinance No. O-047-2017, which pertains to relationships with external agencies and establishes policies and procedures with respect to funding external agencies; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. O-047-2017 allows for the creation and establishment of review panels, to wit: (a) Community Development Arts Review Panel and (b) Community Development Social Services Review Panel (each, a "Panel"); and

WHEREAS, members of the respective Panels are charged with the duty and responsibility to review and evaluate all applications for funding by the Lafayette City-Parish Consolidated Government submitted by external agencies within the purview of the Panel; and

WHEREAS, each Panel has convened and has developed recommendations with respect to the external agencies to which funding should be extended and the amount of funding; and

WHEREAS, these recommendations are hereby submitted to the Lafayette Mayor-President and Lafayette City Council, and attached as exhibits to this resolution; and

**WHEREAS**, the funding recommendations of the respective Panels must be affirmed by the Lafayette City Council before grants can be awarded to external agencies.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Lafayette City Council, that:

**SECTION 1:** All of the aforedescribed "Whereas" clauses are adopted as part of this resolution.

**SECTION 2:** The Lafayette City Council hereby affirms the Panels' recommendations for funding of the external agencies that applied to the 2022-2023 External Agencies Funding Program, as shown in the attached Exhibits A and B.

SECTION 3: The Lafayette City Council hereby authorizes the Director of the Community Development & Planning Department, or her designee, to execute and process all documents associated with the External Agencies Funding Program, including, but not limited to, applications, public service contracts, amendments, payment requests and so on, which may be necessary for the completion of the aforementioned project.

**SECTION 4:** All resolutions, or parts thereof, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

### **ORDINANCE NO. 0-047-2017**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE LAFAYETTE CITY-PARISH COUNCIL ESTABLISHING POLICY AND PROCEDURE PERTAINING TO RELATIONSHIPS WITH EXTERNAL AGENCIES WITH RESPECT TO FUNDING, AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. O-111-2005, AS AMENDED BY ORDINANCE NO. O-283-2010

BE IT ORDAINED by the Lafayette City-Parish Council, that:

SECTION 1: POLICY DECLARATION

A. It is acknowledged that, among the public purposes and functions of a consolidated government under the laws of the State of Louisiana, is the public purpose and function to provide services which aid in enhancing the economic, social, educational and cultural welfare of the citizens of the Lafayette City-Parish Consolidated Government.

B. It is recognized and accepted that there exists within the Parish of Lafayette certain public and private, non-profit agencies and organizations (hereinafter referred to as "external agencies"), which, because of proven expertise, experience and organizational structure, can provide certain services in a manner deemed to be more effective and efficient than would be possible by the Lafayette City-Parish Consolidated Government.

C. Selection and Funding - It is hereby declared it shall be the policy of the Lafayette City-Parish Consolidated Government to annually consider proposals for funding, from external agencies for the provision of direct services which would otherwise and normally be imposed upon the Lafayette City-Parish Consolidated Government and which aid in the enhancement of the economic, social, educational and cultural well-being of its citizens.

There are hereby created and established the following review panels, to-wit: (a) Community Development Social Services Review Panel and (b) Community Development Arts Review Panel (each, a "Panel"). Each Panel shall be selected by the Community Development Director. The individuals selected to each Panel shall be persons of the age of majority and shall have experience in or knowledge of the subject matter of the Panel, but shall not be employed by any external agency seeking funding pursuant to this ordinance. The Panels shall have the duty and responsibility to review and evaluate all applications submitted for funding to the Lafayette City-Parish Consolidated Government by external agencies within the purview of the Panel. Each Panel shall make its recommendation with respect to the external agencies to which funding should be extended and the amount of the funding. Such recommendation shall be submitted in writing to the Lafayette Mayor-President who shall forward same to the Lafayette City-Parish Council. The amounts allocated for external agencies (including in the categories of Arts & Culture and Social Services) shall only be disbursed upon the approval of the Lafayette City-

Parish Council by resolution after consideration of the recommendations submitted and developed by the relevant Panel.

### **SECTION 2: PROCEDURE**

A. Notification - The Community Development Director is hereby authorized and directed to submit to the Clerk of the Lafayette City-Parish Council a "Public Notice" to be published annually in the Lafayette City-Parish Consolidated Government's official journal (and other print media he or she deems appropriate), notifying external agencies of the submittal date and requirements for funding proposals. Additionally, the Community Development Director shall give written notification which shall be mailed to all external agencies which had received direct funding from the Lafayette City-Parish Consolidated Government in the most recent external agency funding cycle. The Public Notice shall be published and the written notifications mailed during the month of July and shall specify an application period of not less than 30 days and not to exceed 60 days following the date of publication.

- B. Submittal Requirements Any external agency desiring consideration from the Lafayette City-Parish Consolidated Government for direct funding to be provided by the Lafayette City-Parish Consolidated Government shall be obligated to submit on or before the established date a formal proposal to the Community Development Director which shall include, but not be limited to, the following:
- (1) An application form which outlines the proposal and includes statements concerning the amount of direct funding being requested, a brief description of services to be provided by the external agency, when services will be provided, to whom services will be provided, and what economic, social, educational and/or cultural benefits will accrue to the citizens of the Parish of Lafayette. The application form shall be signed by the president of the external agency.
- (2) A board of directors resolution or a clause of assurances authorizing the president or the executive director to submit the application to the Lafayette City-Parish Consolidated Government on behalf of the external agency.
- (3) An annual budget, adopted by the external agency's board of directors, which includes identification of all revenue sources and amounts and a detailed listing of proposed expenditures by category (i.e., an overall agency detailed line item budget). If direct funding is being requested, the external agency shall include the amount of the Lafayette City-Parish Consolidated Government funding request on the revenue side of the budget proposal.
- (4) A detailed programmatic description which includes information on services to be provided, to whom, when, where and how; what economic, social, educational and/or

cultural benefits are expected to accrue to the citizens of Parish of Lafayette; and, the external agency's capacity to perform the services described.

- (5) A statement indicating whether or not the amount being requested from the Lafayette City-Parish Consolidated Government is needed to match a federal, state or foundation grant.
  - (6) Articles of Incorporation.
  - (7) Evidence of tax-exempt status.
- (8) The most recent audit report or, if no audit has been performed, the most recent financial statements compiled or reviewed by a Certified Public Accountant, or other financial reports as required by law.
- C. Selection and Funding The Community Development Director is hereby authorized to receive all proposals for external agency funding. Following review, the Lafayette Mayor-President shall make recommendations for external agency funding to the Lafayette City-Parish Council. The Lafayette Mayor-President's recommendations shall be predicated on, but not limited to, funding availability, the extent of benefits anticipated to accrue to the citizenry, past performance of the external agency with respect to fulfilling previous Lafayette City-Parish Consolidated Government funding requirements, and its capacity to perform the described services. The Lafayette City-Parish Council, as its sole discretion, shall have final and absolute responsibility and authority for selection of external agencies for funding and the amounts of funding they are to receive. In the event an external agency is selected to receive funding, the amount it receives shall be included as an appropriation in the budget of the Community Development Department and the appropriation shall be designated as "direct funding".
- D. Public Service Contract External agencies selected for funding shall be required to enter into a "Public Service Contract" with the Lafayette City Parish Consolidated Government. The Lafayette Mayor-President shall be authorized to approve all Public Service Contracts. The Lafayette Mayor-President shall not consider a Public Service Contract for external agency funding unless a proper and adequate appropriation has been budgeted.
- E. Departmental Oversight and Monitoring It shall be the responsibility of the Community Development Director and/or his or her designee for oversight and monitoring to insure compliance with the provisions of the Public Service Contract and, especially, the performance reporting requirements noted therein and below. It shall be the responsibility of the Community Development Director and/or his or her designee to notify the Lafayette City-Parish Council of any non-compliance.

- F. Minority/Woman's Business Enterprise Utilization Any external agency receiving Lafayette City-Parish Consolidated Government funding shall be required to consider utilizing, to the greatest extent possible, minority and woman-owned businesses for the acquisition of goods and services.
- G. Report Requirements Any external agency receiving Lafayette City-Parish Consolidated Government funding shall be required to submit to the Community Development Director and/or his or her designee various reports and documents during and following the fiscal year for which Lafayette City-Parish Consolidated Government funding is provided. At a minimum, these shall include:
- (1) A final report and accounting within 30 days following the end of the fiscal year, or by December 1. The report shall include a detailed description of actual services provided, a detailed financial accounting, information of what economic, social, educational and/or cultural benefits were derived for citizens of the Parish of Lafayette, an evaluation of the agency's performance in providing the services, and documentation of minority/women business enterprise utilization.
- (2) Financial reports, submitted within six (6) months following the end of the agency's fiscal year, as follows:
- (a) An annual audit report prepared in accordance with Government Auditing Standards and 2 CFR Part 200, as applicable.
- (b) If an agency does not meet the revenue threshold of total funds from all sources which triggers an audit, financial statements compiled by a Certified Public Accountant in accordance with Statements on Standards for Accounting and Review Services issued by the American Institute of Certified Public Accountants, or other financial reports as required by law.

SECTION 3: Ordinance No. O-111-2005, adopted on May 17, 2005, as amended by Ordinance No. O-283-2010, adopted on December 21, 2010, is hereby repealed.

**SECTION 4:** All ordinances and resolutions, or parts thereof, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 5: This ordinance shall become effective upon signature of the Lafayette Mayor-President, the elapse of ten (10) days after receipt by the Lafayette Mayor-President without signature or veto, or upon an override of a veto, whichever occurs first.

SECTION 1: Section 2.C of Ordinance No. O-111-2005 adopted by the Lafayette City-

The Community Development Social Services Review Panel shall be selected by the Director of the Department of Community Development. The Acadiana Center for the Arts Review Panel shall be selected by the Acadiana Center for the Arts Review Panel shall be selected by the Acadiana Center for the Arts. The individuals selected to each Panel shall be persons of the age of majority and shall have experience in or knowledge of the subject matter of the Panel, but shall not be employed by any external agency seeking funding pursuant to this ordinance. The Panels shall have the duty and responsibility to review and evaluate all applications for funding by the Lafayette City-Parish Consolidated Government submitted by external agencies within the purview of the Panel. Each Panel shall make its recommendation with respect to the external agencies to which funding should be extended and the amount of the funding. Such recommendation shall be submitted in writing to the Lafayette City-Parish President who shall forward same to the Council. The amounts allocated for external agencies (including in the categories of Arts & Culture and Social Services) shall only be disbursed upon the approval of the City-Parish Council by resolution of the recommendations submitted and developed by the relevant Panel.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE LAFAYETTE CITY-PARISH COUNCIL PERTAINING TO RELATIONSHIPS WITH EXTERNAL AGENCIES AND ESTABLISHING POLICY AND PROCEDURE WITH RESPECT TO FUNDING, AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 0-090-97

BE IT ORDAINED by the Lafayette City-Parish Council:

SECTION 1: POLICY DECLARATION

- A. It is acknowledged that, among the public purposes and functions of a consolidated government under the laws of the State of Louisiana, is the public purpose and function to provide services which aid in enhancing the economic, social, educational and cultural welfare of the citizens of the Lafayette City-Parish Consolidated Government.
- B. It is recognized and accepted there exists within the Parish of Lafayette certain public and private, non-profit agencies and organizations (hereinafter referred to as "external agencies"), which, because of proven expertise, experience and organizational structure, can provide certain services in a manner deemed to be more effective and efficient than would be possible by the Lafayette City-Parish Consolidated Government.
- C. It is hereby declared it shall be the policy of the Lafayette City-Parish Consolidated Government to annually consider proposals for funding, from external agencies for the provision of direct services which would otherwise and normally be imposed upon the Lafayette City-Parish Consolidated Government and which aid in the enhancement of the economic, social, educational and cultural well being of its citizens.

### SECTION 2: PROCEDURE

A. Notification- The Director of the Department of Community Development of the Lafayette City-Parish Consolidated Government is hereby authorized and directed to submit to the Clerk of the Lafayette City-Parish Council a "Public Notice" to be published annually in the Lafayette City-Parish Consolidated Government's official journal (and other print media he/she deems appropriate), notifying external agencies of the submittal date and requirements for funding proposals. Additionally, the Director of the Department of Community Development shall give written notification which shall be mailed to all external agencies which had received direct funding from the Lafayette City-Parish Consolidated Government the preceding year. The "Public Notice" shall be published and the written notifications mailed during the month of May and shall specify a submittal date no later than thirty (30) days following the date of publication.

- B. Submittal Requirements Any external agency desiring consideration from the Lafayette City-Parish Consolidated Government for direct funding to be provided by the Lafayette City-Parish Consolidated Government shall be obligated to submit on or before the established date a formal proposal to the Director of the Department of Community Development, with a copy of said proposal to the Clerk of the Lafayette City-Parish Council, which shall include, but not be limited to, the following:
- (1) An application form which outlines the proposal and includes statements concerning the amount of direct funding being requested, a brief description of services to be provided by the external agency, when services will be provided, to whom services will be provided, and what economic, social, educational and/or cultural benefits will accrue to the citizens of the Lafayette City-Parish Consolidated Government. The application form shall be signed by the president of the external agency.
- (2) A board of directors resolution or a clause of assurances authorizing the president or the executive director to submit the application to the Lafayette City-Parish Consolidated Government on behalf of the external agency.
- (3) An annual budget, adopted by the external agency's board of directors, which includes identification of all revenue sources and amounts and a detailed listing of proposed expenditures by category (i.e., an overall agency detailed line item budget). If direct funding is being requested, the external agency shall include the Lafayette City-Parish Consolidated Government and the amount on the revenue side of the budget proposal.
- (4) A detailed programmatic description which includes information on services to be provided, to whom, when, where, and how; what economic, social, educational and/or cultural benefits are expected to accrue to the citizens of the Lafayette City-Parish Consolidated Government; and, the external agency's capacity to perform the services described.
- (5) A statement indicating whether or not the amount being requested from the Lafayette City-Parish Consolidated Government is needed to match a federal, state or foundation grant.
  - (6) Articles of Incorporation.
  - (7) Evidence of tax-exempt status.
- (8) The most recent audit report or, if no audit has been performed, the most recent financial statements compiled or reviewed by a Certified Public Accountant which report or statement shall reflect and report all accounts or funds of any nature or kind

which are available or are credited to the external agency or any trust fund associated with such external agency.

- C. Selection and Funding- The Director of the Department of Community Development of the Lafayette City-Parish Consolidated Government is hereby authorized to receive all proposals for external agency funding. Following review, the Lafayette City-Parish President shall make recommendations for external agency funding to the Lafayette City-Parish Council in conjunction with the Lafayette City-Parish President's annual budget proposal. The Lafayette City-Parish President's recommendations shall be predicated on, but not limited to, funding availability, the extent of benefits anticipated to accrue to the citizenty, past performance of the external agency with respect to fulfilling previous Lafayette City-Parish Consolidated Government funding requirements, and its capacity to perform the described services. The Lafayette City-Parish Council, at its sole discretion, shall have final and absolute responsibility and authority for selection of external agencies for funding and the amounts of funding they are to receive. In the event an external agency is selected to receive funding, the amount it receives shall be included as a line item appropriation in the budget of the Department of Community Development and the appropriation shall be designated as "direct funding".
- D. Public Service Contract: External agencies selected for funding shall be required to enter into a "Public Service Contract" with the Lafayette City Parish Consolidated Government. The Lafayette City-Parish President shall be authorized to approve all "Public Service Contracts". The Lafayette City-Parish President shall not consider a "Public Service Contract" for external agency funding, unless a proper and adequate appropriation has been budgeted.
- E. Departmental Oversight and Monitoring- It shall be the responsibility of the Director of Community Development and/or his designee for oversight and monitoring to insure compliance with the provisions of the "Public Service Contract" and, especially, the performance reporting requirements noted therein and below. It shall be the responsibility of the Director of Community Development and/or his designee to notify the Lafayette City-Parish Council of any non-compliance.
- F. Minority/Woman's Business Enterprise Utilization-Any external agency receiving Lafayette City-Parish Consolidated Government funding shall be required to utilize, to the greatest extent possible, minority and woman-owned business for the acquisition of goods and services.

- G. Reporting Requirements-Any external agency receiving Lafayette City-Parish Consolidated Government funding, shall be required to submit to the Director of Community Development and/or his designed various reports and documents during and following the fiscal year for which Lafayette City-Parish Consolidated Government funding is provided. At a minimum, these shall include:
- (1) A final report and accounting within thirty (30) days following the end of the fiscal year, or by December 1. It shall include a detailed description of actual services provided, a detailed financial accounting, information of what economic, social, educational and/or cultural benefits were derived for Lafayette City-Parish Consolidated Government's citizentry, an evaluation of the agency's performance in providing the services, and documentation of minority/women business enterprise utilization.
- (2) Financial reports, submitted within six (6) months following the end of the agency's fiscal year, as follows:
- (a) If an agency receives \$300,000 or more in total funds from all sources, an audit report prepared in accordance with <u>Government Auditing Standards</u> and OMB Circular A-133, if applicable.
- (b) If an agency receives less than \$300,000 of total funds from all sources, financial statements compiled by a Certified Public Accountant in accordance with statements on Standards for Accounting and Review Services issued by the American Institute of Certified Public Accountants, or, of required under the terms of the contract agreement, the report listed in subparagraph (a) above.

SECTION 3: Ordinance No. O-090-97 adopted on April 15, 1997, is hereby repealed.

SECTION 4: All ordinances and resolutions, or parts thereof in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 5: This ordinance shall become effective upon the signature of the Lafayette City-Parish President, the clapse of ten (10) days after receipt by the Lafayette City-Parish President without signature or veto, or upon override of a veto, whichever occurs first.
