

**CITY ORDINANCE NO. CO-166-2022**

**AN ORDINANCE OF LAFAYETTE CITY COUNCIL CODIFYING THE CAMELLIA  
BOULEVARD LINEAR PARK**

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Lafayette City Council, that:

**WHEREAS**, the Lafayette City-Parish Council by Resolution No R-065-1997 supported the concept of a Linear Park along Camellia Boulevard on the portion North of the Vermillion River; and

**WHEREAS**, the park is a tremendous asset to the community by providing passive recreation and an environment that is conducive to maintaining the integrity of the existing neighborhood; and

**WHEREAS**, it is the intention of the Lafayette City Council that the Camellia Linear Park remain a total greenspace with the exception of the proposed Fire Station Number 6 (the “Fire Station”); and

**WHEREAS**, for the use for Public Purposes of Lafayette City-Parish Consolidated Government, the Lafayette City Council wishes to prohibit the sale of any portion of the Linear Park for commercial or residential development.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED** by the Lafayette City Council, that:

**SECTION 1:** All of the aforescribed “Whereas” clauses are adopted as part of this ordinance.

**SECTION 2:** The Lafayette City Council codifies its continued support for the linear park component of the Camellia Boulevard Extension Project.

**SECTION 3:** The Lafayette City Council supports the use of the land for Public Purposes and hereby prohibits the sale of the land to any developer or other person for commercial or residential development.

**SECTION 4:** The Lafayette City Council prohibits the construction of any facility, public or private, other than the Fire Station on the land known as the Camellia Linear Park.

**SECTION 5:** Lafayette City-Parish Consolidated Government and the City of Lafayette are prohibited to build on, develop or sell the Camellia Linear Park; in part or in full, with the exception of the aforementioned Fire Station.

**SECTION 6:** All ordinances or resolutions, or parts thereof, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

**SECTION 7:** This ordinance shall become effective upon signature of Lafayette Mayor-President, the elapse of ten (10) days after receipt by the Lafayette Mayor-President without signature or veto, or upon an override of a veto, whichever occurs first.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Lafayette City-Parish Council wishes  
to show its support for the linear park component of the Camellia Boulevard Extension Project; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Administration be requested to move forward with  
the education of the affected landowners regarding this project.


