AN ORDINANCE OF THE LAFAYETTE PARISH COUNCIL AMENDING THE FY 22/23 CAPITAL BUDGET OF THE LAFAYETTE CITY-PARISH CONSOLIDATED GOVERNMENT BY TRANSFERRING \$5,600,000.00 FROM FUND 264 FUND BALANCE TO THE BUCHANAN STREET PARKING GARAGE REPAIRS, PHASE II PROJECT (\$3,400,000.00) AND THE LAFAYETTE PARISH COURTHOUSE IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT (\$2,200,000.00) AND APPROPRIATING WITHIN THE PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT

BE IT ORDAINED by the Lafayette Parish Council, that:

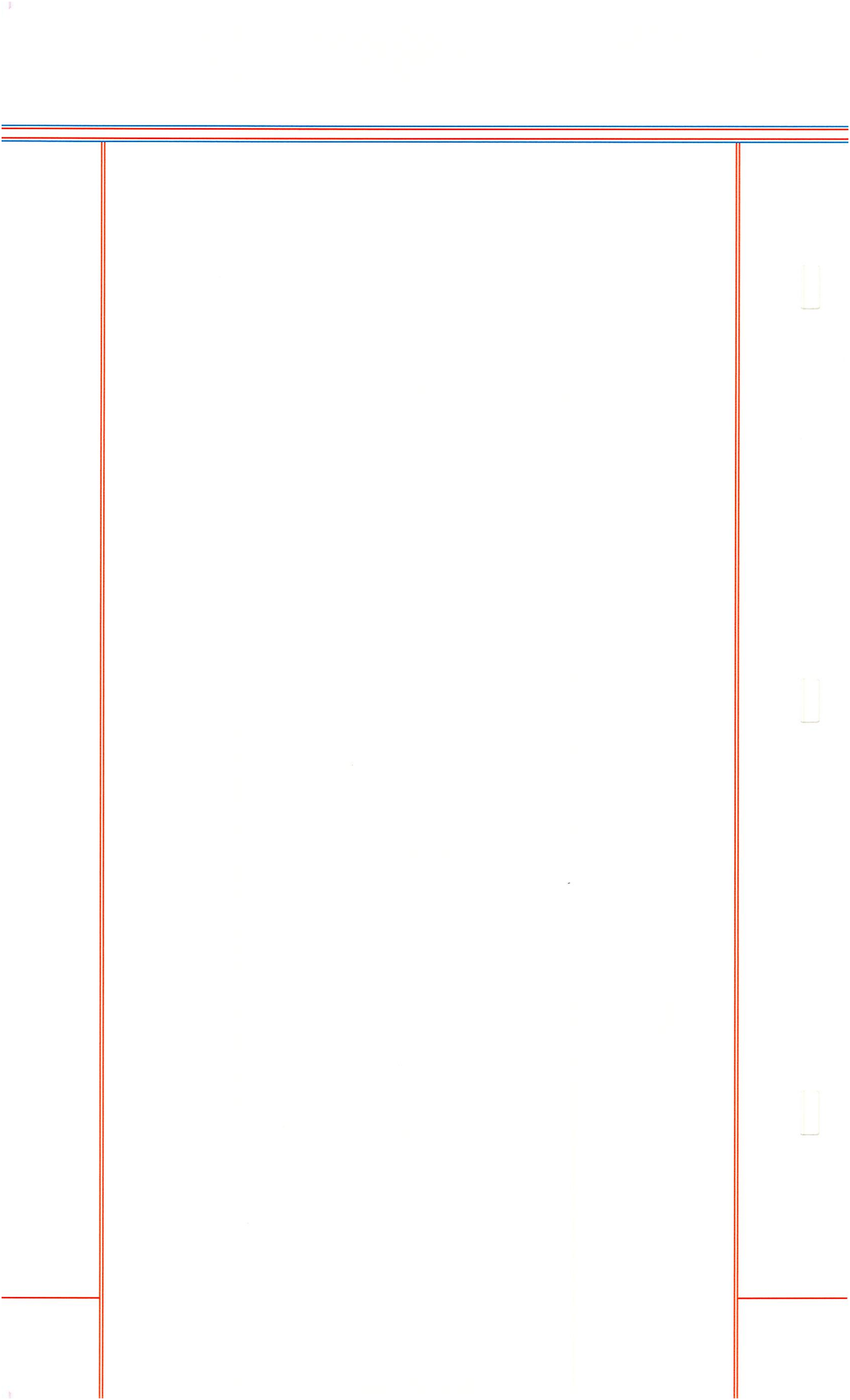
SECTION 1: The FY 22/23 capital budget of the Lafayette City-Parish Consolidated Government is hereby amended by transferring \$5,600,000.00 from Fund 264 Fund Balance to the Buchanan Street Parking Garage Repairs, Phase II Project (\$3,400,000.00) and the Lafayette Parish Courthouse Improvements Project (\$2,200,000.00) and appropriating within the Public Works Department.

SECTION 2: This transfer of funds shall be as reflected in any pertinent documents which are attached hereto and made a part hereof and filed in the Office of the Lafayette Clerk of the Council.

SECTION 3: All ordinances or resolutions, or parts thereof, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4: This ordinance shall become effective upon signature of the Lafayette Mayor-President, the elapse of ten (10) days after receipt by the Lafayette Mayor-President without signature or veto, or upon an override of a veto, whichever occurs first.
