

**ORDINANCE NO. JO-103-2022**

**A JOINT ORDINANCE OF THE LAFAYETTE CITY COUNCIL AND THE LAFAYETTE PARISH COUNCIL AMENDING THE FY 22/23 CAPITAL BUDGET OF THE LAFAYETTE CITY-PARISH CONSOLIDATED GOVERNMENT BY INCREASING THE USE OF NET LOSS-USE OF FUND BALANCE (FUND 260) IN THE AMOUNT OF \$250,000.00 AND BY TRANSFERRING \$250,000.00 IN FUNDS FROM THE DULLES DRIVE WIDENING ACTIVITY (FUND 401) AND RE-APPROPRIATING SAID FUNDS WITHIN THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT AND PLANNING DEPARTMENT, GRANTS ADMINISTRATION FOR THE FUNDING OF TWO (2) NEW CAPITAL ACTIVITIES AND AUTHORIZING THE LAFAYETTE MAYOR-PRESIDENT TO EXECUTE ANY DOCUMENTS NECESSARY FOR THE SUCCESSFUL ADMINISTRATION OF THIS UNDERTAKING**

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Lafayette City Council and the Lafayette Parish Council, that:

**WHEREAS**, the Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act (heretofore the “IIJA”), also known as the Bipartisan Infrastructure Law was signed into law in November of 2021; and

**WHEREAS**, the IIJA appropriation is the largest long-term investment in this nation’s infrastructure as well as its economy and includes funding for infrastructure improvements such as roads, bridges, mass transit, water infrastructure, community resilience, and broadband; and

**WHEREAS**, Lafayette Consolidated Government is desirous of making application for funding through the IIJA; and

**WHEREAS**, due to the complexity, length, and magnitude of this funding opportunity, it will be necessary for Lafayette Consolidated Government to engage a consultant for assistance in the identification of relevant project grant opportunities, in the drafting and submission of grant applications, and with the administrative and management associated with grant activities; and

**WHEREAS**, funding for this initiative has been authorized through the use of Net Loss-Use of Fund Balance in Fund 260 and identified through an existing Fund 401 appropriation.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED** by the Lafayette City Council and the Lafayette Parish Council that:

**SECTION 1:** All of the aforescribed “Whereas” clauses are adopted as part of this ordinance.

**SECTION 2:** The FY 22/23 capital budget of the Lafayette Consolidated Government is hereby amended by increasing the use Net Loss-Use of Fund Balance by \$250,000 and appropriating to a new parish “Infrastructure Investment & Jobs Act” activity for the accommodation of consultant costs.

**SECTION 3:** The FY 22/23 capital budget of the Lafayette Consolidated Government is hereby further amended by transferring \$250,000 in funds from the Dulles Drive Widening activity to a new city “Infrastructure Investment & Jobs Act” activity to accommodate consultant costs.

**SECTION 4:** The Lafayette City Council and the Lafayette Parish Council do hereby authorize the Lafayette Mayor-President, or his designee, to conduct all negotiations, execute and submit all documents, including but not limited to applications, agreements, amendments, payment requests, memoranda of understanding and so on, which may be necessary for the completion of the aforementioned projects.

**SECTION 5:** This transfer of funds shall be as reflected in any pertinent documents which are attached hereto and made a part hereof and filed in the Office of the Clerk of the Lafayette City-Parish Council.

**SECTION 6:** All ordinances or resolutions, or parts thereof, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

**SECTION 7: EFFECTIVE DATE.** After first having been adopted by a majority of the authorized membership of both the Lafayette Parish Council and the Lafayette City Council, this joint ordinance shall become effective upon signature of this joint ordinance by the Lafayette Mayor-President, the elapse of ten (10) days after receipt by the Lafayette Mayor-President without signature or veto, or upon override of a veto, whichever occurs first.
