AN ORDINANCE OF THE LAFAYETTE CITY COUNCIL AMENDING THE FY 22/23 OPERATING AND CAPITAL BUDGETS OF THE LAFAYETTE CITY-PARISH CONSOLIDATED GOVERNMENT BY INCREASING THE USE OF PRIOR YEAR FUND BALANCE IN THE SALES TAX CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT – CITY FUND (401) BY \$92,000 AND APPROPRIATING \$12,000 INTO A PROJECT TO REMOVE THE EXISTING CAMPGROUND HOUSE AND \$80,000 INTO A PROJECT TO RENOVATE THE CAMPGROUND OFFICE WITHIN THE PARKS, ARTS, RECREATION AND CULTURE DEPARTMENT

BE IT ORDAINED by the Lafayette City Council, that:

SECTION 1: The FY 22/23 operating and capital budgets of the Lafayette City-Parish Consolidated Government are hereby amended by increasing the Use of Prior Year Fund Balance in the Sales Tax Capital Improvement – City Fund (401) by \$92,000 and appropriating \$12,000 into a project to remove the existing campground house and \$80,000 into a project to renovate the campground office within the Parks, Arts, Recreation and Culture Department.

SECTION 2: The Lafayette City Council does hereby authorize the Lafayette Mayor-President, or his designee, to conduct all negotiations, execute and submit all documents, including but not limited to applications, agreements, amendments, payment requests, memoranda of understanding and so on, which may be necessary for the completion of the aforementioned projects.

SECTION 3: This transfer of funds shall be as reflected in any pertinent documents which are attached hereto and made a part hereof and filed in the Office of the Lafayette Clerk of the Council.

SECTION 4: All ordinances or resolutions, or parts thereof, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 5: This ordinance shall become effective upon signature of the Lafayette Mayor-President, the elapse of ten (10) days after receipt by the Lafayette Mayor-President without signature or veto, or upon an override of a veto, whichever occurs first.
