I am a lifelong resident of Lafayette Parish, so when deciding on a career in public service and law enforcement I knew that I wanted to serve my hometown community of Lafayette.

Hired by the Lafayette Police Department in May of 1995, I've served in all four divisions, including the Patrol Division, Criminal Investigations Division, Services Division and the Administrative Division. I have also served in the Traffic, Evidence, and Special Events/Occurrences Units. Furthermore, I have served as the Administrative Lieutenant to Precinct 4, Watch Commander and ultimately concluding my time with Lafayette Police Department as the Chief of Police. I have dedicated most of my career to the Lafayette Police Department, and I am honored to have served my community in these capacities over the years.

I have had the opportunity to develop my skills over the past nearly 26 years. I served in the capacity of a police officer and detective for the first 15 years of my career. I was promoted to Corporal, Sergeant, Lieutenant and Chief of Police, serving in supervisory and administrative capacities for 11 years. Throughout my career, I have been called upon to produce documents, predict departmental needs, review and create departmental policies, facilitate purchases, plan and mitigate major events, and manage and maintain various budgets.

I am a graduate of Louisiana State University at Eunice with degrees in Forensic Science and Emergency Services.

I hope that my experience in the aforementioned areas will assist you in your selection process.

Considerations:

- **Career History:** I have served in all four divisions within the Lafayette Police Department. These include the Patrol Division, Criminal Investigations, Services, and Administrative Divisions. I have also served in the Traffic, Evidence and Special Events and Occurrences Units. Additionally, I have served as an Administrative Lieutenant, Watch Commander and most recently Interim Chief of Police.

Administration – *Chief of Police*

As the Chief of Police my duties included the supervision of more than three hundred employees including Patrol, Investigations, Administration, Records and Fleet. I was in charge of recognizing employees performing exemplary work, as well, initiating internal investigations and the issuance of disciplinary action within the department of Police.

My duties also included the analyzation of crime trends and mitigation procedures, addressing quality of life concerns. I worked closely with the Mayor and Council Members to accomplish common goals as it relates to the protection of citizens.

Watch Commander – *Lieutenant*

As the Watch Commander, I was responsible for the day-to-day responses to calls for service within the city. I managed a shift of twenty-four officers assigned to a squad. We answered all immediate calls for service from 911 Emergency Communications. I oversaw the proper distribution of manpower to assure calls are handled efficiently. I was responsible for the overall supervision of all in-progress incidents and notifications of our support sections and outside agencies. I was also charged with addressing complaints of officers and an agreeable resolution to those communications.

Administrative Patrol – *Lieutenant Precinct 4*

As the Administrative Lieutenant for Precinct 4, I was charged with the direct and indirect supervision of Precinct 4 manpower encompassing approximately 20 to 30 officers and first line supervisors. I maintained personnel files and assured that all entries were submitted by supervisors. I reviewed individual cases and videos to assure officers adhered to the standards and policies of the Lafayette Police Department. I was also responsible for addressing quality of life issues for residents of Precinct 4. I was charged with analyzing crimes that occurred during the week and developed techniques to combat future crimes.

Services Division – *Sergeant*

As the Sergeant of the Services Division, I was assigned to the Unusual Occurrences Unit, and was responsible for the mitigation and response to natural and manmade disasters, such as, ice storms, floods, hurricanes, train derailments, and major accidents. I was responsible for maintaining emergency equipment and coordinating available manpower. Additionally, I was the first line supervisor for deployment of that manpower and equipment. I was also responsible for managing all operations during a disaster and performing Emergency Operations Command responsibilities. Following an incident, my duties continued long after; I would assure the return of equipment and report expenditures for budgeting and finances.

As a member of the Special Events Unit, I was responsible for planning and executing police security for all parades, festivals, footraces and civic events. This includes mock drills, planning efficient road

closures, rerouting traffic, civilian personal safety mitigation and grounds security. I was responsible for several "line item" budgets for each of these events totaling in the hundreds of thousands of dollars with a 100% success rate.

Evidence Unit – Corporal and Sergeant

As a member of the Evidence Unit, I was responsible for the intake of all Lafayette Police Department evidence collected for each case investigated by our agency. My responsibilities also involved the submission, cataloging, tracking, storing and presentation of evidence along with courtroom testimony relating to its integrity.

As the supervisor of the Evidence Unit, I was responsible for the same duties as the evidence custodian. Additionally, I was tasked with assuring the efficient operation of the unit and the budgeting for materials and improvements.

Criminal Investigations Division – Detective and Sergeant

As a member of the Criminal Investigations Division, I was responsible for investigating misdemeanor and felony crimes as a detective and a supervisor. I conducted investigations and sought the resolution of thefts, burglaries, sexual assaults, and homicides.

As a supervisor, I was responsible for the day-to-day and clandestine operations of multiple subordinates who were tasked with investigating and managing their respective cases, assuring reports were completed, and cases submitted for prosecution. Following the investigation, I provided courtroom testimony in many of those cases.

Patrol Division - Police Officer, Corporal and Sergeant

As a member of the Patrol Division, I was responsible for protecting and serving the community as a police officer and supervisor. I conducted regular patrols and investigated street level cases. Following these investigations, I provided courtroom testimony for many of the incidents.

As a Sergeant, I was responsible for the same duties as a patrol officer. Additionally, I was responsible for assuring that call loads were distributed based on span of control measures, subordinates completed investigations in a timely manner and reports were completed properly.

Traffic Unit – Patrol Motor Officer

As a member of the Traffic Unit, I was responsible for traffic enforcement and crash investigations within the city. Additionally, I was responsible for investigating fatal crashes and their submittal for prosecutorial consideration. Following the investigations, I provided courtroom testimony during civil and criminal phases of trial.
