### PARISH ORDINANCE NO. PO-048-2024

AN ORDINANCE OF THE LAFAYETTE PARISH COUNCIL AUTHORIZING THE LAFAYETTE MAYOR-PRESIDENT TO EXECUTE AGREEMENT(S) WITH SHERIFFS, MUNICIPALITIES, POLITICAL SUBDIVISIONS OR AGENCIES CONCERNING TEMPORARY HOUSING OF JUVENILES IN THE JUVENILE JUSTICE SYSTEM AND TO AMEND THE FY 23/24 OPERATING BUDGET OF THE LAFAYETTE CITY-PARISH CONSOLIDATED GOVERNMENT BY INCREASING THE USE OF PRIOR YEAR FUND BALANCE IN FUND 265 IN THE AMOUNT OF \$125,000 AND APPROPRIATING WITHIN THE JUVENILE DETENTION DIVISION WITHIN THE CAO'S OFFICE

BE IT ORDAINED by the Lafayette Parish Council, that:

WHEREAS, Children's Code article 804(1), as amended and reenacted by Senate Bill No. 3 of the 2024 Second Extraordinary Session of the Louisiana Legislature, redefined the term "child" as "any person under the age of twenty-one, including an emancipated minor, who commits a delinquent act before attaining seventeen years of age;" and

WHEREAS, this legislative action has generated questions regarding its implications to the criminal justice system, creating significant uncertainty as to the housing and detention of minors who have attained the age of 17; and

WHEREAS, various State and Federal Statutes provide that juveniles must not be detained or confined in an institution where they come in contact with adult inmates; and

WHEREAS, for the general welfare of the citizens of the Parish of Lafayette, the Lafayette Parish Council desires to authorize the Lafayette Mayor-President to enter into such agreements with qualifying political subdivisions or agencies, including sheriffs or law enforcement districts, to temporarily house juveniles arrested and initially held in the Parish of Lafayette.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED by the Lafayette Parish Council, that:

**SECTION 1:** All of the aforedescribed "Whereas" clauses are adopted as part of this ordinance.

SECTION 2: The Lafayette Parish Council hereby authorizes the Lafayette Mayor-President to enter into one (1) or more agreements with any political subdivision or agency, including sheriffs or law enforcement districts, certified as a lawful juvenile detention facility to house juveniles arrested and initially held in the juvenile justice system of the Parish of Lafayette.

SECTION 3: The agreement(s) authorized herein shall be in such form, and contain such additional provisions, as the Lafayette Mayor-President may deem necessary, convenient, or desirable to carry out the intent and provisions of this ordinance.

SECTION 4: The Lafayette Parish Council hereby further authorizes the Lafayette Mayor-President to take any and all other action in connection with the agreement(s) authorized herein in order to carry out the intent of this ordinance.

SECTION 5: The FY 23/24 operating budget of the Lafayette City-Parish Consolidated Government is hereby amended by increasing the use of prior year fund balance in the amount of \$125,000 and appropriating within the Juvenile Detention Division within the CAO's Office.

SECTION 6: The increase in revenue shall be reflected in any pertinent documents which are attached and made a part hereof and filed in the Office of the Lafayette Clerk of the Council.

**SECTION 7:** All ordinances or resolutions, or parts thereof, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 8: This ordinance shall become effective upon signature of the Lafayette Mayor-President, the elapse of ten (10) days after receipt by the Lafayette Mayor-President without signature or veto, or upon an override of a veto, whichever occurs first.
