

CITY RESOLUTION NO. CR-015-2024

A RESOLUTION OF THE LAFAYETTE CITY COUNCIL AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF A JOINT APPLICATION WITH THE LAFAYETTE PARISH SHERIFF'S OFFICE WITH THE U. S. DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE FOR A 2024 BJA JAG ASSISTANCE GRANT FOR THE LAFAYETTE POLICE DEPARTMENT

BE IT RESOLVED by the Lafayette City Council, that:

WHEREAS, the Lafayette Police Department will jointly apply for a BJA JAG grant with the Lafayette Parish Sheriff's Department from the U.S. Department of Justice in the amount of \$74,457; and

WHEREAS, these funds are to be split by the Lafayette Police department and the Lafayette Parish Sheriff's Department; and

WHEREAS, these funds will be used by the Lafayette Police Department for crime cameras; and

WHEREAS, upon completion of all required documents and meeting all special conditions of the program, the Lafayette Police Department will be notified of the final approval of funds; and

WHEREAS, upon notification of final approval and award of funds, the Lafayette Mayor-President as the authorized signing official will complete the award acceptance documentation including signature; and the Lafayette Police Department will submit the required budgetary revision to the Lafayette City Council for approval prior to expenditure of any grant funds.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Lafayette City Council, that:

SECTION 1: All of the aforescribed "Whereas" clauses are adopted as part of this resolution.

SECTION 2: The Lafayette City Council hereby authorizes the filing of an application with the U.S. Department of Justice Office of Justice Programs.

SECTION 3: The Lafayette City Council hereby authorizes the Lafayette Mayor-President, or her designee, to conduct all negotiations, execute and submit all documents, including but not limited to the application, agreements, award documents, amendments, payment requests, and so on, which may be necessary to complete the aforementioned project.

SECTION 4: All resolutions, or parts thereof, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

This resolution having been submitted to a vote, the vote on behalf of the Lafayette City Council thereon was as follows:


