AN ORDINANCE OF THE LAFAYETTE PARISH COUNCIL AMENDING THE FY 24/25 OPERATING BUDGET OF THE LAFAYETTE CITY-PARISH CONSOLIDATED GOVERNMENT BY INCREASING REVENUES IN THE AMOUNT OF \$154,700.55 IN EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT PERFORMANCE GRANT (EMPG) AND STATE HOMELAND SECURITY PROGRAM (SHSP) FUNDS RECEIVED FROM THE GOVERNOR'S OFFICE OF HOMELAND SECURITY AND EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS (GOHSEP) AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS WITHIN THE LAFAYETTE PARISH OFFICE OF HOMELAND SECURITY AND EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS

BE IT ORDAINED by the Lafayette Parish Council, that:

SECTION 1: The FY 24/25 operating budget of the Lafayette City-Parish Consolidated Government is hereby amended by increasing revenues in the amount of \$154,700.55, received from the Governor's Office of Homeland Security and Emergency Preparedness. The GOHSEP funding is awarded under the Federal Fiscal Year 2024 (FY 2024) Emergency Management Performance Grant (EMPG) in the amount of \$62,305.23 and FY 2024 State Homeland Security Program (SHSP) in the amount of \$92,395.32, and appropriating funds within the Lafayette Parish Office of Homeland Security and Emergency Preparedness.

SECTION 2: This increase in revenues shall be as reflected in any pertinent documents which are attached hereto and made a part hereof and filed in the Office of the Clerk of the Council.

SECTION 3: The purpose of the EMPG to assist state, local, tribal, and territorial efforts in emergency management to enhance our ability to prepare for, prevent where possible, respond to, recover from and mitigate against emergency and disaster events, including an all-hazards approach, which addresses natural, accidental or man-made events.

SECTION 4: The purpose of the SHSP is assists state, local, tribal, and territorial efforts to build, sustain, and deliver the capabilities necessary to prevent, prepare for, protect against, and respond to acts of terrorism.

SECTION 5: The Lafayette City-Parish Consolidated Government will use the funds to implement projects for the parish of Lafayette emergency management and first responder agencies as approved by the Parish Emergency Management Advisory Committee (PEMAC) in accordance with La. R.S. 29:727(I).

SECTION 6: There is no matching requirement for these grant programs.

SECTION 7: The Lafayette Mayor-President, or her designee, is hereby authorized to amend the operating budget within the grant period by transferring any unexpended appropriated balances into or out of salaries and benefits line items and all other expense line items in order to expend the total award amount in accordance with the EMPG and SHSP regulations.

SECTION 8: All ordinances or resolutions, or parts thereof, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 9: This ordinance shall become effective upon signature of the Lafayette Mayor-President, the elapse of ten (10) days after receipt by the Lafayette Mayor-President without signature or veto, or upon an override of a veto, whichever occurs first.
