### ORDINANCE NO. JO-004-2025

A JOINT ORDINANCE OF THE LAFAYETTE CITY COUNCIL AND THE LAFAYETTE PARISH COUNCIL AMENDING THE FY 24/25 OPERATING BUDGET OF THE LAFAYETTE CITY-PARISH CONSOLIDATED GOVERNMENT BY INCREASING REVENUES IN THE AMOUNT OF \$810,000 RECEIVED FROM THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT'S LEAD HAZARD REDUCTION CAPACITY BUILDING GRANT PROGRAM, APPROPRIATING CAPACITY BUILDING FUNDS WITHIN THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT AND PLANNING DEPARTMENT, AND APPROPRIATING \$155,359 OF COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) FUND BALANCE WITHIN THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT AND PLANNING DEPARTMENT AS LEVERAGE FOR THE CAPACITY BUILDING GRANT PROGRAM

BE IT ORDAINED by the Lafayette City Council and the Lafayette Parish Council, that:

WHEREAS, Lafayette City-Parish Consolidated Government (LCG) submitted a grant application for the Lead Hazard Reduction Capacity Building Grant Program to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) Office of Lead Hazard Control and Healthy Homes; and

WHEREAS, LCG intends to leverage the Lead Hazard Reduction Capacity Building program by allocating Federal Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds, also received by HUD; and

WHEREAS, HUD has approved LCG's Capacity Building grant application in the amount of \$810,000.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED by the Lafayette City Council and Lafayette Parish Council, that:

**SECTION 1:** All of the aforedescribed "Whereas" clauses are herein adopted as part of this ordinance.

SECTION 2: The FY 24/25 operating budget of the LCG is hereby amended by increasing revenues in the amount of \$810,000 received from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development's Lead Hazard Reduction Capacity Building Grant Program (LHR-CB) and appropriating within the Community Development and Planning Department.

SECTION 3: The FY 24/25 operating budget of LCG is hereby further amended by designating \$155,359 in Federal CDBG funds within the Community Development and Planning Department toward the Lead Hazard Reduction Capacity Building Program.

**SECTION 4:** The purpose of this program is to educate and enhance the ability of LCG, area non-profit organizations, and area private contractors to properly identify and safely remediate lead-based paint in older Lafayette homes; as well as to perform remediation in the third and final year of the program.

SECTION 5: There is no matching requirement for this grant; however, LCG is providing an applicant cost-share for this program in order to enhance the program's effectiveness. The cost-share includes \$155,359 in Federal CDBG Fund Balance to supplement program costs, an in-kind match of \$31,326 of CDBG for staff time related to managing the grant funds and preaward training, and in-kind match of \$41,050 City General Fund for staff time related to managing the program activities.

SECTION 6: The Lafayette Mayor-President, or her designee, is hereby authorized to amend the operating budget within the grant period by transferring any unexpended appropriated balances into or out of salaries and benefits line items and all other expense line items in order to expend the total award amount in accordance with Federal regulations.

SECTION 7: The Lafayette City Council and Lafayette Parish Council hereby authorize the Lafayette Mayor-President, or her designee, to conduct all negotiations, execute and submit all documents, including but not limited to applications, agreements, amendments, payment requests and so on, which may be necessary for the completion of the aforementioned project.

**SECTION 8:** This increase in revenues shall be as reflected in any pertinent documents which are attached hereto and made a part hereof and filed in the Office of the Clerk of the Council.

**SECTION 9:** All ordinances or resolutions, or parts thereof, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 10: After first having been adopted by a majority of an authorized membership of both the Lafayette Parish Council and the Lafayette City Council, this joint ordinance shall become effective upon signature of this joint ordinance by the Lafayette Mayor-President, the elapse of ten (10) days after receipt by the Lafayette Mayor-President without signature or veto, or upon override of a veto, whichever occurs first.

Attached is an ordinance and corresponding budgetary revision reflecting the allocation of \$810,000 in Lead Hazard Reduction Capacity Building Grant (LHR-CB) funds to be received from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD), as well as the allocation of \$155,359 in CDBG Fund Balance as leverage. LCG is also providing an in-kind match of \$26,643 CDBG for staff time to manage the grant funds and for preaward training, as well as in-kind match of \$41,050 City General Fund for staff time to manage the program itself.

These funds are to be used for LCG's new Lead Hazard Reduction Capacity Building program to educate and enhance the ability of LCG, area non-profits, and private contractors in properly identifying and safely remediating lead-based paint in older Lafayette homes. There is no matching requirement for this grant, however the leveraged CDBG funds will allow for a more effective program. The grant was awarded to Lafayette Consolidated Government and its jurisdiction, so the ordinance will be presented as a Joint Agenda Item.

If this ordinance meets your approval, please have this item placed on the Joint Council agenda for introduction on January 21, 2025, with final adoption consideration on February 4, 2025.
