

ORDINANCE NO. JO-010-2025

A JOINT ORDINANCE OF THE LAFAYETTE CITY COUNCIL AND THE LAFAYETTE PARISH COUNCIL AMENDING THE FY 24/25 OPERATING BUDGET OF THE LAFAYETTE CITY-PARISH CONSOLIDATED GOVERNMENT BY AUTHORIZING THE TRANSFER OF \$500,000 IN HOME INVESTMENT PARTNERSHIPS PROGRAM (HOME) FUNDS WITHIN THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT & PLANNING DEPARTMENT TO THE EXTRA MILE REGION IV

BE IT ORDAINED by the Lafayette City Council and the Lafayette Parish Council, that:

SECTION 1: The FY 24/25 operating budget of the Lafayette City-Parish Consolidated Government is hereby amended by transferring \$500,000 in HOME funds within the Community Development & Planning Department to The Extra Mile Region IV. Funds will be used to assist with the costs related to the construction of transitional housing at the Meredith's Place Residential Facility.

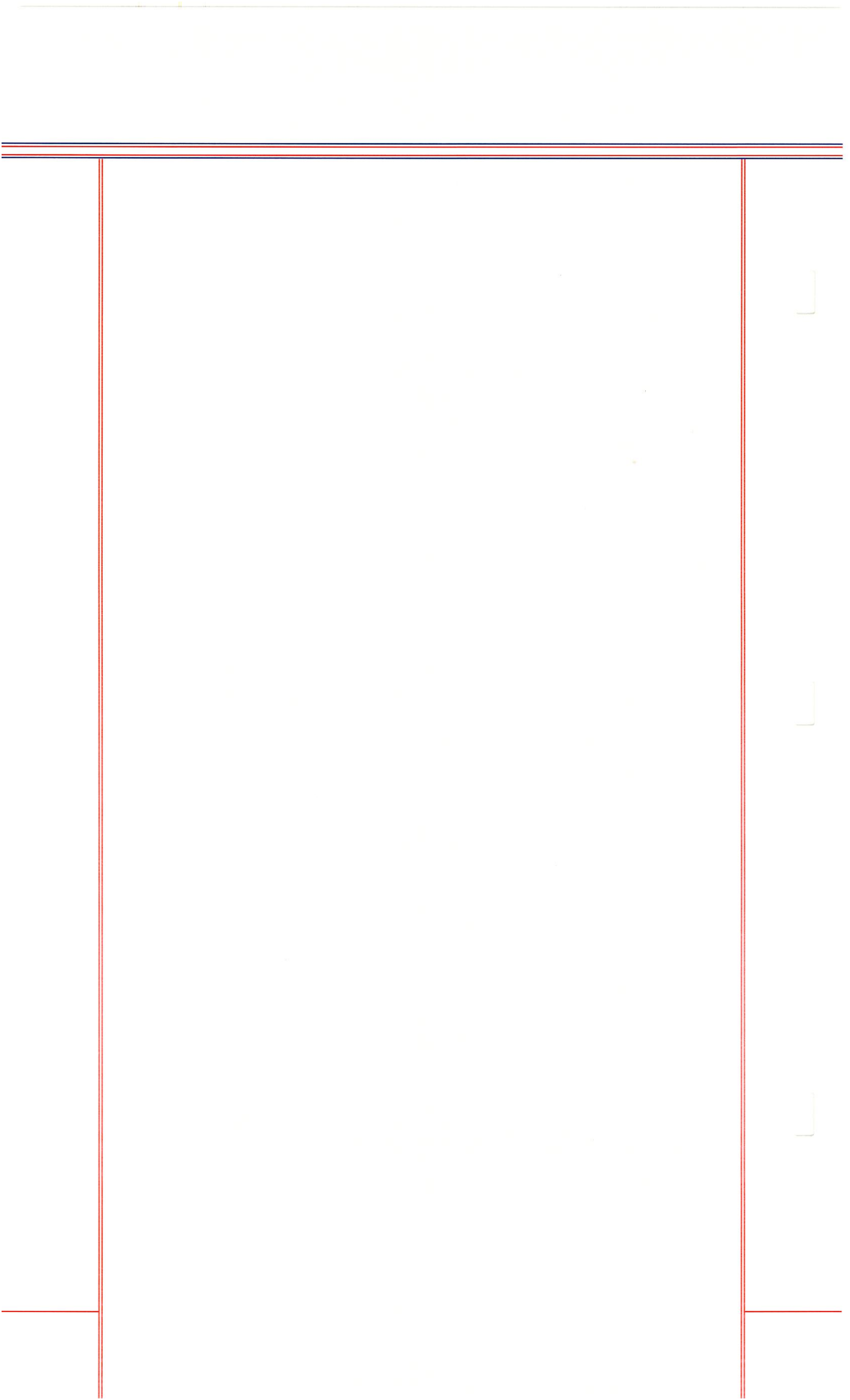
SECTION 2: The transfer of funds shall be contingent upon the completion of an environmental review and the Finding of No Significant Impact, as reached in accordance with HUD environmental review regulations.

SECTION 3: The Lafayette Parish Council and the Lafayette City Council hereby authorize the Lafayette Mayor-President, or her designee, to conduct all negotiations, execute and submit all documents, including but not limited to applications, agreements, amendments, payment requests, memoranda of understanding and so on, which may be necessary for the completion of the aforementioned project.

SECTION 4: This transfer of funds shall be as reflected in any pertinent documents which are attached hereto and made a part hereof and filed in the Office of the Clerk of the Council. The Lafayette Mayor-President, or her designee, is hereby authorized to amend the operating budget within the grant period by transferring any unexpended appropriated balances into or out of salaries and benefits line items and all other expense line items in order to expend the total award amount in accordance with the HOME regulations.

SECTION 5: All ordinances or resolutions, or parts thereof, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 6: After first having been adopted by a majority of the authorized membership of both the Lafayette Parish Council and the Lafayette City Council, this joint ordinance shall become effective upon signature of this joint ordinance by the Lafayette Mayor-President, the elapse of ten (10) days after receipt by the Lafayette Mayor-President without signature or veto, or upon override of a veto, whichever occurs first.


