

**CITY RESOLUTION NO. CR-007-2025**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE LAFAYETTE CITY COUNCIL APPROVING A  
DISBURSEMENT OF FUNDS TO THE CAJUNDOME**

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Lafayette City Council, that:

**WHEREAS**, the Cajundome was budgeted an amount of \$500,000 for the operating subsidy and said amount was approved by the Council in the Fiscal Year (FY) 24-25 budget; and

**WHEREAS**, Ordinance No. JO-040-2024 adopted on September 17, 2024 also provided that the Cajundome appropriation shall only be disbursed upon the approval of the Lafayette City Council, via resolution passed by the favorable vote of at least a majority of the authorized membership of the Lafayette City Council; and

**WHEREAS**, the Cajundome has submitted a request an amount for half of the operating subsidy for FY 2024-2025 in the amount of \$250,000; and

**WHEREAS**, the Cajundome requests approval for disbursement of this funding amount so Lafayette City-Parish Consolidated Government could release the funds.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Lafayette City Council, that:

**SECTION 1:** All of the aforescribed “Whereas” clauses are adopted as part of this resolution.

**SECTION 2:** The Lafayette City Council, in accordance with Ordinance No. JO-040-2024, Section 3(K), approves this disbursement to the Cajundome.

**SECTION 3:** All resolutions, or parts thereof, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

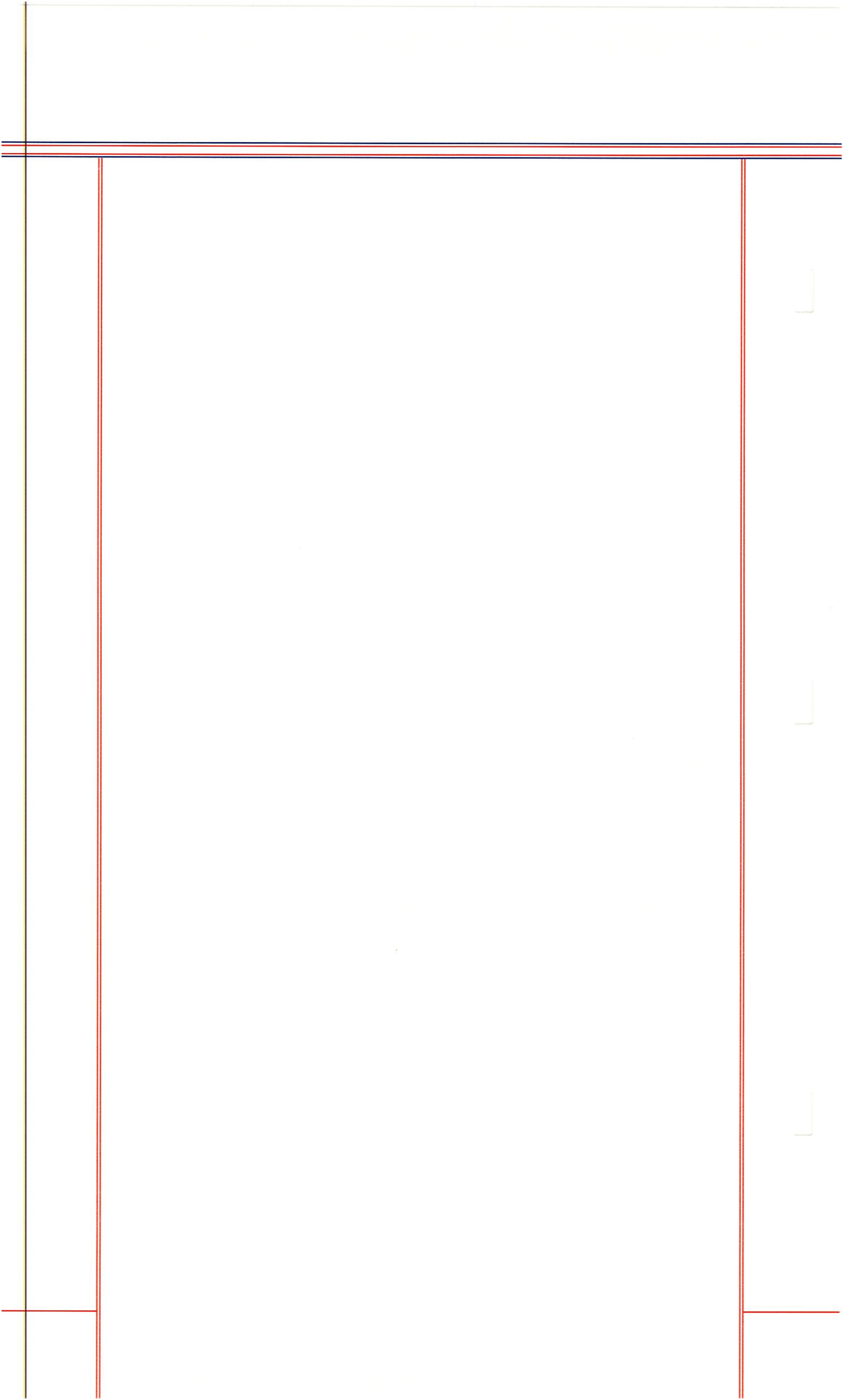
