

PARISH ORDINANCE NO. PO-031-2026

AN ORDINANCE OF THE LAFAYETTE PARISH COUNCIL AMENDING THE FY 25/26 CAPITAL BUDGET OF THE LAFAYETTE CITY-PARISH CONSOLIDATED GOVERNMENT BY TRANSFERRING FUNDS FROM VARIOUS ACCOUNTS TO THE E BROUSSARD/ROBLEY DRIVE ROUNDABOUT ACCOUNT FOR ADDITIONAL FUNDING NEEDED

BE IT ORDAINED by the Lafayette Parish Council, that:

SECTION 1: The FY 25/26 capital budget of the Lafayette City-Parish Consolidated Government is hereby amended by transferring funds from various accounts to the E Broussard/Robley Drive Roundabout account for additional funding needed.

SECTION 2: The aforesaid adjustments shall be as reflected in any pertinent documents which are attached hereto and made a part hereof and filed in the Office of the Clerk of the Council.

SECTION 3: All ordinances or resolutions, or parts thereof, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4: This ordinance shall become effective upon signature of the Lafayette Mayor-President, the elapse of ten (10) days after receipt by the Lafayette Mayor-President without signature or veto, or upon an override of a veto, whichever occurs first.
