

PARISH ORDINANCE NO. PO-039-2026

AN ORDINANCE OF THE LAFAYETTE PARISH COUNCIL AUTHORIZING THE LAFAYETTE CITY-PARISH CONSOLIDATED GOVERNMENT TO SELL AT PUBLIC AUCTION AND PUBLIC INTERNET AUCTION SURPLUS VEHICLES, EQUIPMENT AND OTHER MISCELLANEOUS MOVABLE PROPERTY WHICH ARE NO LONGER NEEDED FOR PUBLIC PURPOSES, AS PER THE ATTACHED LIST (PUBLIC AUCTION AND PUBLIC INTERNET AUCTION)

BE IT ORDAINED by the Lafayette Parish Council, that:

SECTION 1: The Lafayette City-Parish Consolidated Government has in storage surplus equipment and other miscellaneous LCG movable property which are no longer needed for public purposes, as per the attached list.

SECTION 2: It would be in the best interest of the Lafayette City-Parish Consolidated Government to sell this movable property at a public auction and public internet auction to the highest bidder.

SECTION 3: The attached list represents the surplus LCG movable property to be sold.

SECTION 4: All items shall be sold in an "as-is, where-is" condition. The Lafayette City-Parish Consolidated Government reserves the right to reject any or all bids, establish minimum bid prices, or withdraw any items from the sale.

SECTION 5: The Lafayette Mayor-President, Monique B. Boulet, be and she is hereby authorized and directed to sell at a public auction and public internet auction surplus LCG movable property as per the attached list.

SECTION 6: It is specifically recognized that all requirements of the State law pertaining to the sale of surplus movable property including notice of this proposed ordinance to the public shall be adhered to.

SECTION 7: Any opposition to this ordinance shall be made in writing and filed with the Office of the Clerk of the Council within 15 days of first publication.

SECTION 8: All ordinances or resolutions, or parts thereof, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 9: This ordinance shall become effective upon signature of the Lafayette Mayor-President, the elapse of ten (10) days after receipt by the Lafayette Mayor-President without signature or veto, or upon override of a veto, whichever occurs first.
