

ORDINANCE NO. JO-023-2020

**A JOINT ORDINANCE OF THE LAFAYETTE CITY COUNCIL AND THE
LAFAYETTE PARISH COUNCIL REORGANIZING THE LAFAYETTE PARISH
LIBRARY BOARD OF CONTROL**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Lafayette City Council and the Lafayette Parish Council,
that:

SECTION 1: LEGISLATIVE INTENT Pursuant to Section 7-07 of the Lafayette City-Parish Consolidated Government Home Rule Charter, on or before June 1, 2020, the Lafayette City Council and the Lafayette Parish Council, jointly, shall, by ordinance, create, consolidate, merge, abolish, reorganize, or reaffirm any administrative boards or commissions in existence on that date. Accordingly, the Lafayette City Council and the Lafayette Parish Council do hereby reorganize the Lafayette Parish Board of Control under the terms and conditions contained in this Joint Ordinance.

SECTION 2: PRESENT BOARD As of the effective date of the Lafayette City-Parish Consolidated Government Home Rule Charter, as amended, there was in existence a Lafayette Parish Board of Control for the Parish of Lafayette, last reorganized pursuant to Ordinance No. O-020-97.

SECTION 3: NAME The Board shall continue to be known as the Lafayette Parish Library Board of Control.

SECTION 4: NUMBER OF MEMBERS The Board shall consist of eight (8) members.

SECTION 5: METHOD OF APPOINTMENT In accordance with state law, including but not limited to La. R.S. 25:214, the Parish Council shall appoint seven (7) members to the Board, each of which shall be a citizen of Lafayette Parish. The President of Lafayette Parish shall be, ex officio, a member of the Board, provided however that the President shall have the right to designate another member of the governing authority of the parish to serve in his/her place and stead on the Board in accordance with La. R.S. 25:214(B).

**A) AFFIRMATION OF CURRENT TERMS OF MEMBERS OF THE PRESENT
BOARD AND SUBSEQUENT APPOINTMENTS TO THE REORGANIZED**

BOARD Unless earlier terminated at the pleasure of the appointing authority pursuant to Section 5 of this Joint Ordinance, members currently serving on the present Library Board of Control shall continue to serve until the expiration date of their current term.

B) AFFIRMED AND SUBSEQUENT APPOINTMENTS All members whose terms are affirmed herein, and all those appointed hereinafter, shall serve at the pleasure of the appointing authority and shall otherwise continue to serve until the expiration date of the term for which they are appointed. All appointments shall be made by the

designated appointing authority for a term of five (5) years from the date of appointment in accordance with La. R.S. 25:214.

SECTION 6: GENERAL POLICY The Lafayette Parish Library Board of Control, as reorganized, shall be subject to the general policy for all boards, commissions and/or agencies established in any Resolution by the Lafayette City-Parish Council (previously adopted and still in effect) and/or any Resolution by the Lafayette Parish Council.

SECTION 7: SEVERABILITY Should any portion of this Joint Ordinance be declared unconstitutional by any Court of competent jurisdiction, the remaining clauses will remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 8: EXISTING CONTRACTS NOT AFFECTED This Joint Ordinance is adopted subject to all existing contracts between the present Library Board of Control, before it is reorganized and/or restructured by this Joint Ordinance, and any other person or governmental body except as may be herein repealed.

SECTION 9: REPEAL All ordinances or resolutions, or parts thereof, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed, including but not limited to, any conflicting portion of Ordinance No. O-020-97 of the Lafayette City-Parish Council.

SECTION 10: EFFECTIVE DATE After first having been adopted by a majority of the authorized membership of both the Lafayette Parish Council and the Lafayette City Council, this Joint Ordinance shall become effective upon signature of this Joint Ordinance by the Lafayette Mayor-President, the elapse of ten (10) days after receipt by the Lafayette Mayor-President without signature or veto, or upon override of a veto, whichever occurs first.
