- 12. <u>CO-108-2020</u> An ordinance of the Lafayette City Council approving a conditional use permit to allow a drive-through restaurant in a MN-1 (Mixed-Use Neighborhood) Zoning District, Case No. ZON2020-0022, 604 East Willow Street Conditional Use Permit, located generally north of East Willow Street, west of Louisiana Avenue, and east of Pecan Orchard Road.
