VETOED ORDINANCE

The Lafayette Mayor-President on Thursday, August 26, 2021, returned Ordinance No. JO-049-2021 with seven (7) line items vetoed and has provided a statement of explanation which has been published in the Official Journal on Thursday, September 2, 2021.

In accordance with Section 2-13(C) of the Lafayette City-Parish Consolidated Government Home Rule Charter, vetoed ordinances shall be submitted to the Council that initially passed the ordinance no later than the next regular meeting held after publication of veto statement.

Also, in accordance with Section 2-13(B) of the Lafayette City-Parish Consolidated Government Home Rule Charter, all ordinances vetoed by the Lafayette Mayor-President shall be vetoed in full, except that the Lafayette Mayor-President shall have authority to veto individual appropriation items in the ordinances adopting the operating and capital improvement budgets and amendments thereto.

JO-049-2021 A joint ordinance of the Lafayette City Council and the Lafayette Parish Council amending the FY 20/21 operating and capital budget of the Lafayette City-Parish Consolidated Government by increasing revenues and expenditures in the amount of \$85,726,551 in Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds awarded from the U.S. Department of the Treasury and adopting the American Rescue Plan Act Budget. (Finance)

- g) Veto No. 7: #69, Downtown Lafayette Police Precinct, \$50,000
