A RESOLUTION OF THE LAFAYETTE CITY COUNCIL CONDEMNING THE USE OF BALLOON RELEASES AS PART OF A PUBLIC OR PRIVATE EVENT, PROMOTIONAL ACTIVITY, OR OTHER CELEBRATORY OR MEMORIAL GATHERING AND ENCOURAGING THE USE OF OTHER ECO-FRIENDLY AND SAFE ALTERNATIVES

BE IT RESOLVED by the Lafayette City Council ("City Council"), that:

WHEREAS, the City of Lafayette finds that the release into the atmosphere of balloons inflated with lighter-than-air gases ("Balloon Releases") poses a danger and nuisance to the environment, particularly to wildlife and marine animals; and

WHEREAS, the City of Lafayette also finds that Balloon Releases are known to cause power outages and have recently caused at least one major power outage in the City of Lafayette; and

WHEREAS, the City of Lafayette recognizes the need for its citizens, from time to time, to conduct a public or private event, promotional activity, or other celebratory or memorial gathering, but desires to protect the environment and avoid power outages by condemning the use of Balloon Releases at said events and encouraging the use of other available eco-friendly and safe alternatives;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Lafayette City Council, that:

SECTION 1: All of the aforementioned "Whereas" clauses in the preamble of this resolution are adopted as part of this resolution.

SECTION 2: The City of Lafayette hereby condemns the use of Balloon Releases as part of a public or private event, promotional activity, or other celebratory or memorial gathering.

SECTION 3: The City of Lafayette encourages and supports the use of other available eco-friendly and safe alternatives to the use of Balloon Releases, said alternatives include but are not limited to, the releasing of flowers on water, the blowing of bubbles, the use of candlelight vigils, and the planting of trees.

SECTION 4: All resolutions, or parts thereof, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
