A JOINT RESOLUTION OF THE LAFAYETTE CITY COUNCIL AND THE LAFAYETTE PARISH COUNCIL APPROVING AND ADOPTING ROUTE LAFAYETTE WAYFINDING AND SIGN STANDARD PLAN

BE IT RESOLVED by the Lafayette City Council and the Lafayette Parish Council, that:

WHEREAS, the Lafayette City-Parish Planning Commission adopted Resolution No. R-2014-01, approving and adopting PlanLafayette as Lafayette's comprehensive plan; and

WHEREAS, the Lafayette City-Parish Council adopted Resolution No. R-026-2014 endorsing the Lafayette City-Parish Planning Commission's action regarding PlanLafayette; and

WHEREAS, PlanLafayette recommends the design and installation of wayfinding signage that promotes historical resources, tourism, streetscape, and education; and

WHEREAS, wayfinding signage connects people to places and experiences, establishes a city's brand strategy and brings measurable economic return; and

WHEREAS, it is desirous that all departments, with the exception of LUS Utilities and LUS Fiber, of Lafayette Consolidated Government have standardized signage for all streets, transit, directional, public buildings, public parks, etc.; and

WHEREAS, the French language is an important part of the culture in Acadiana and for tourists attracted to the rich culture of this region.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Lafayette City-Parish Council and the Lafayette Parish Council, that:

SECTION 1: All of the aforedescribed "Whereas" clauses are adopted as part of this resolution.

SECTION 2: All signs fabricated and installed by departments, with the exception of LUS Utilities and LUS Fiber, of Lafayette Consolidated Government will follow the templates of the planned signs as identified by the document titled "Route Lafayette Wayfinding and Sign Standard Plan" as found in Exhibit A, a copy of which is attached hereto and made a part hereof.

SECTION 3: All signs as installed by departments of Lafayette Consolidated Government will be bilingual with French secondary except for the Downtown Development District where French will be primary with English secondary.

SECTION 4: All signs fabricated and installed by Department of Traffic, Roads, and Bridges, where practical, will follow the templates of the planned signs as identified by the document titled "Route Lafayette Wayfinding and Sign Standard Plan" as found in Exhibit A, a copy of which is attached hereto and made a part hereof.

SECTION 5: All resolutions or parts thereof in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.






