

**PARISH ORDINANCE NO. PO-046-2021**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE LAFAYETTE PARISH COUNCIL AMENDING THE FY 20/21 CAPITAL BUDGET OF THE LAFAYETTE CITY-PARISH CONSOLIDATED GOVERNMENT BY INCREASING REVENUES IN THE AMOUNT OF \$4,725,000 IN COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT-MITIGATION FUNDS RECEIVED FROM THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT, APPROPRIATING SAID FUNDS WITHIN THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT AND PLANNING DEPARTMENT, AND AUTHORIZING THE CONTRIBUTION OF \$875,000 IN PARISH DRAINAGE FUNDS WITHIN THE PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT TO THE COULEE MINE EAST FLOOD CONTROL PROJECT**

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Lafayette Parish Council, that:

**WHEREAS**, Lafayette City-Parish Consolidated Government has been conditionally awarded \$4,725,000 in Community Development Block Grant – Mitigation (CDBG-MIT) funds from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development, as administered by the Louisiana Office of Community Development under the Louisiana Watershed Initiative for the purpose of building necessary flood water detention ponds on Coulee Mine East; and

**WHEREAS**, within the grant application, the Public Works Department indicated that Lafayette City-Parish Consolidated Government would commit \$875,000 of Parish Funds to this same project; and

**WHEREAS**, to receive the conditionally awarded funding, the Lafayette City-Parish Consolidated Government must demonstrate by ordinance the dedication of all project funding.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED** by the Lafayette Parish Council, that:

**SECTION 1:** All of the aforescribed “Whereas” clauses are adopted as part of this ordinance.

**SECTION 2:** The FY 20/21 capital budget of the Lafayette City-Parish Consolidated Government is hereby amended by increasing revenues in the amount of \$4,725,000 in CDBG-MIT funds received from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development and contributing \$875,000 in Parish Drainage Funds within the Public Works Department to the Coulee Mine East Flood Control Project.

**SECTION 3:** The transfer of funds shall be contingent upon completion of an environmental review and the finding of no significant impact as reached in accordance with HUD environmental review regulations.

**SECTION 4:** The Lafayette Parish Council does hereby authorize Joshua S. Guillory, as the duly elected Lafayette Mayor-President, to conduct all negotiations, execute and submit all documents, including but not limited to applications, agreements, amendments, payment requests, memoranda of understanding and so on, which may be necessary for the completion of the

aforementioned project.

**SECTION 5:** This increase in revenues and transfer of funds shall be as reflected in any pertinent documents which are attached hereto and made a part hereof and filed in the Office of the Lafayette Clerk of the Council.

**SECTION 6:** All ordinances or resolutions, or parts thereof, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

**SECTION 7:** This ordinance shall become effective upon signature of the Lafayette Mayor-President, the elapse of ten (10) days after receipt by the Lafayette Mayor-President without signature or veto, or upon an override of a veto, whichever occurs first.

In fulfillment of the Louisiana Watershed Initiative's long-term resilience objectives, participating LWI state agencies have reviewed your application for the **Coulee Mine East Flood Control Project** submitted for the **Watershed Projects Grant Program: Local and Regional - Round 1**. Based on this review, the Office of Community Development has conditionally awarded **\$4,725,000** for the above referenced project.

To help ensure project costs remain eligible for reimbursement, you must **avoid any choice-limiting actions** (described below) and adhere to the required conditions and clearances, as listed below:

1. Environmental clearance must be obtained for any CDBG-funded activity **before** entering into any contracts, property purchase agreements, demolition/grading of land, or other choice-limiting actions. The Environmental Review Record (ERR)<sup>1</sup> for this project must be received by our office by Wednesday, **Dec. 23, 2021**. If extenuating circumstances prevent submission of the ERR, you must notify us in writing before **Nov. 1, 2021**, and request a time extension. OCD reserves the right to determine whether valid grounds exist for a time extension. For example, a valid reason would be jurisdictional agency letters that were mailed, but concurrence not yet received by one or more of those agencies. Any requests for an extension must include documentation demonstrating that every attempt has been made to meet the deadline, along with the reason(s) for missing the deadline. Failure to comply with the prohibition against committing funds or taking physical action

- before completion of the environmental review process could result in cancellation of the project, reimbursement by the grantee to HUD for the amount expended or suspension of the disbursement of funds for the affected activity.
2. For projects involving construction, clearance of plans and specifications must be obtained before advertising for bids, awarding construction contracts or beginning construction. Additionally, you are required to ensure that proper Davis-Bacon wage determinations are applied to construction activities and/or construction contracts when CDBG funds are used for construction activities (24 CFR 906.37). For this project, your plans and specifications must be **SUBMITTED** by **Wednesday Dec. 23, 2021**. If extenuating circumstances exist that prevent submission, you must notify us in writing before **Nov. 1, 2021**, and request a time extension. OCD reserves the right to determine whether valid grounds exist for a time extension. Any requests for an extension must include documentation demonstrating that every attempt has been made to meet the deadline, along with the reason(s) for missing the deadline. Make sure to inform your architects and engineers of this deadline. If needed, OCD technical assistance is available.
  3. A final cost estimate prepared and signed by a Licensed Architect or Professional Engineer who is licensed in the state of Louisiana must be submitted to OCD by **Dec. 23, 2021**. The cost estimate shall contain the total cost of construction (estimated quantity, unit of measure, unit price and amount) and all related project costs including, but not limited to, project delivery, acquisition, architectural/engineering fees, etc. Please note that costs for grant management services and total project delivery are subject to the capped amounts listed in Section 3.3 (pgs. 14 -15) of the Round 1 Policies and Procedures. Similarly, professional design costs for basic services or additional services are subject to the individual and total capped percentages detailed in the same section of the policy.
  4. All costs that exceed the original funding request will be the responsibility of the grantee. Evidence of confirmed funding commitment for remaining project costs must be submitted to OCD by Dec. 23, 2021. Reimbursement of any costs from CDBG funds, including those for services, fees, etc. that were listed in the approved application will be limited to amounts deemed reasonable by OCD.
  5. Prior to their finalization, the applicant must submit draft project design details and management plans to Louisiana Department of Wildlife and Fisheries for review and approval. LDWF ensures that adverse impacts to natural functions are avoided or minimized to the greatest extent practicable. Please contact LDWF Biologist Matthew Weigel at [mweigel@wlf.la.gov](mailto:mweigel@wlf.la.gov) for additional information.





