

**CITY ORDINANCE NO. CO-179-2021**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE LAFAYETTE CITY COUNCIL AMENDING THE FY 21/22  
OPERATING AND CAPITAL BUDGET OF THE LAFAYETTE CITY-PARISH  
CONSOLIDATED GOVERNMENT BY DECREASING COUNCIL RESERVES IN FUND  
650 AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN/21-CITY FUND IN THE AMOUNT OF \$250,000 AND  
APPROPRIATING WITHIN THE PARKS, ARTS, RECREATION & CULTURE  
DEPARTMENT FOR THOMAS PARK SKATE PARK**

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Lafayette City Council, that:

**SECTION 1:** The FY 21/22 operating and capital budget of the Lafayette City-Parish Consolidated Government is hereby amended by decreasing Council Reserves in Fund 650 American Rescue Plan/21-City Fund in the amount of \$250,000 and appropriating within the Parks, Arts, Recreation & Culture Department for Thomas Park Skate Park.

**SECTION 2:** This transfer of funds shall be contingent upon the Lafayette City-Parish Consolidated Government's adherence to all applicable Federal laws, including 2 CFR 200, and all regulations assigned by the U.S. Department of the Treasury in connection with the American Rescue Plan Act.

**SECTION 3:** This project is classified as Expenditure Category 6.1 – Provision of Government Services as required in the U.S. Treasury's Compliance and Reporting Guidance.

**SECTION 4:** The Lafayette City Council does hereby authorize the Lafayette Mayor-President, or his designee, to conduct all negotiations, execute and submit all documents, including but not limited to applications, agreements, amendments, payment requests, memoranda of understanding and so on, which may be necessary for the completion of the aforementioned project.

**SECTION 5:** This transfer of funds shall be as reflected in any pertinent documents which are attached hereto and made a part hereof and filed in the Office of the Lafayette Clerk of the Council.

**SECTION 6:** All ordinances or resolutions, or parts thereof, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

**SECTION 7:** This ordinance shall become effective upon signature of the Lafayette Mayor-President, the elapse of ten (10) days after receipt by the Lafayette Mayor-President without signature or veto, or upon an override of a veto, whichever occurs first.




