- e of the Lafavette Parish Council amending Parish nce No. PO-052-2021 amending the FY 21/22 operating and capital budget of the Lafayette City-Parish Consolidated Government by decreasing Council Reserves in Fund 651 American Rescue Plan/21-Parish Fund in the amount of \$2,960,000 and appropriating within the Volunteer Fire Departments for Volunteer Fire Department Tanker Trucks (7). (Fire)
- 7. PO-011-2022 An ordinance of the Lafayette Parish Council amending the FY 21/22 capital budget of the Lafayette City-Parish Consolidated Government by decreasing Council Reserves in Fund 651 American Rescue Plan/21-Parish Fund in the amount of \$2,000,000.00 and appropriating within the Public Works Department for the Bayou Vermilion Flood Control - CIDC Project. 9. JO-016-2022 A joint ordinance of the Lafayette City Council and the Lafayette Parish Council authorizing the Lafayette Mayor-President to enter into an Intergovernmental Agreement with the Lafayette Parish School Board for the joint use of recreational facilities. (Legal)

- 10. <u>JO-017-2022</u> A joint ordinance of the Lafayette City Council and the Lafayette Parish Council amending the FY 21/22 operating budget of the Lafayette City-Parish Consolidated Government by transferring \$1,619,072 from Fund 607 Group Hospitalization Fund to Fund 101 City General Fund for the actuarial payment to the Municipal Employees' Retirement System (MERS). (Finance)
- 11. JO-019-2022 A joint ordinance of the Lafayette City Council and the Lafayette Parish Council amending the FY 21/22 capital budget of the Lafayette City-Parish Consolidated Government by transferring \$10,000 in funds from BRIDGE REPAIRS-PARISH budget line item to ICE MACHINE RPL-1 budget line item for additional funding needed within the Traffic, Roads, and Bridges Department, Street Division. (Traffic, Roads and Bridges)

JO-020-2022 A joint ordinance of the Lafayette City Council and the Lafayette Parish Council amending the FY 21/22 operating budget of the Lafayette City-Parish Consolidated Government by increasing revenues in the amount of \$3,549,084 including \$2,661,813, 75% received from the State of Louisiana, Governor's Office of Homeland Security and Emergency Preparedness, under the FEMA Hazard Mitigation Grant Program (HMGP), FEMA-4570-DR-LA (Hurricane Delta) Grant, \$887,271, 25% match from Lafayette City-Parish Consolidated Government Public Works Parish Street, Drainage, Bridge Fund and participating property owners for the acquisition or elevation of repetitive loss and severe repetitive loss properties, and construction of a drainage pond near Oaks Spring Subdivision, and appropriating within the Community Development & Planning Department and authorizing the Lafayette Mayor-President to enter into Inter-Governmental Agreement(s) with any municipalities in the Parish of Lafayette related to the acquisition, demolition, and subsequent transfer of properties acquired through the FEMA Hazard Mitigation Grant Program. (Community Development and Planning)
- 13. <u>JO-021-2022</u> A joint ordinance of the Lafayette City Council and the Lafayette Parish Council amending the Lafayette Development Code (LDC), Chapter 89 of the Lafayette City-Parish Consolidated Government Code of Ordinances. (Community Development and Planning)
