- 9. <u>CO-046-2022</u> An ordinance of the Lafayette City Council declaring the five (5) buildings or structures located at 1421 South East Evangeline Thruway, Lafayette, Louisiana, owned by Sunshine Hospitality, L.L.C., through its sole members, Karam Ali and Altaf Panjwani, c/o Gerald J. Block, attorney appointed, to be dilapidated and dangerous to the public welfare and ordering the condemnation of same. (Community Development and Planning)
