## PARISH ORDINANCE NO. PO-049-2022

AN ORDINANCE OF THE LAFAYETTE PARISH COUNCIL SETTING FORTH AND DESIGNATING THE ADJUSTED AD VALOREM TAX MILLAGE RATE AND IMPOSING TAXES ON ALL PROPERTY SUBJECT TO AD VALOREM TAXATION IN THE PARISH OF LAFAYETTE AND AUTHORIZING THE TAX ASSESSOR AND TAX COLLECTOR FOR THE PARISH OF LAFAYETTE TO ASSESS AND COLLECT THE MILLAGE RATE FOR 2022 AT THE RATE OF 1.71 MILLS FOR THE LAFAYETTE AIRPORT COMMISSION

BE IT ORDAINED by the Lafayette City-Parish Council, that:

SECTION 1: In a public hearing held on September 20th, 2022, which hearing was conducted in accordance with the open meetings law and the additional requirements of Article VII, Section 23 (C) of the Constitution, that the following millage rate be and it is hereby levied upon the dollar of the assessed valuation of all property subject to ad valorem taxation within said Parish for the year 2022 for the purpose of raising revenue:

### **MILLAGE**

Lafayette Airport Commission

1.71 mills

**SECTION 2:** The Assessor of the Parish of Lafayette shall extend upon the assessment roll for the year 2022 the tax herein levied, and the tax collector of said Parish shall collect and remit the same to said taxing authority in accordance with law.

**SECTION 3:** The foregoing ordinance was read in full, the roll was called on the adoption thereof, and the ordinance was adopted by the following votes:

Annually, the Lafayette Parish Tax Assessor's Office provides information relative to levied Millages for the current and upcoming year and requires the governing body to vote on its adoption. This information usually comes in July, but it is not expected to change since this is not a reassessment year. These O&M funds support LAC's costs for Airfield Maintenance, ARFF, Security, Insurance, Environmental, and Utilities among other expenses. Staff suggests that the LAC maintain for 2023 the approved rate of 1.71 mils and forward to the Lafayette Consolidated Government for action.
