BE IT RESOLVED by the Lafayette City Council and the Lafayette Parish Council, that:

WHEREAS, the Inflation Reduction Act (H.R.5376) was enacted on August 16, 2022; and

WHEREAS, grant funds may become available through a number of agencies of the U.S. Federal Government; and

WHEREAS, the time frame for application submittal for grant funds may not afford the opportunity to meet Ccuncil deadlines for the submittal of items for consideration by resolution.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Lafayette City Council and the Lafayette Parish Council, that:

SECTION 1: All of the aforedescribed "Whereas" clauses are adopted as part of this resolution.

SECTION 2: The Lafayette City-Parish Consolidated Government is hereby authorized to submit applications for grant funds with the requirement that the Councils be apprised of such applications upon submittal, that no such applications bind the Lafayette City-Parish Consolidated Government for match funds, and that each such application be brought before the Councils for consideration by ordinance in order to budget grant funds.

SECTION 3: The Lafayette Mayor-President, or his designee, is hereby authorized to conduct all negotiations, execute, and submit all documents, including but not limited to, applications, agreements, amendments, payment requests, memoranda of understanding, and so on, which may be necessary for the completion of the aforementioned project(s).

SECTION 4: Such further terms as may be reflected in any pertinent documents pertaining to grant applications, and any such documents on file in the Office of the Lafayette Clerk of the Council in connection with this resolution, are made a part hereof by reference.

SECTION 5: All resolutions or parts thereof, in conflict, herewith are hereby repealed.
