- 13. <u>CO-113-2023</u> An ordinance of the Lafayette City Council amending the FY 22/23 capital budget of the Lafayette City-Parish Consolidated Government by transferring \$500,000 in American Rescue Plan/21-City 650 Funds from the Pickleball Courts account to the Asphalt Overlay Program account and transferring \$500,000 in 401 Funds from the Urban Asphalt Overlay/Reconstruction account to the Pickleball Courts account and appropriating within the Public Works Department. (Public Works)
- 14. <u>CO-114-2023</u> An ordinance of the Lafayette City Council amending the FY 22/23 capital budget of the Lafayette City-Parish Consolidated Government by transferring \$350,0000 from Fund 401 (Sales Tax Capital Improvement City) Fund Balance to the 2023 Urban Asphalt Overlay Project and appropriating within the Public Works Department. (Public Works)
- 15. <u>CO-115-2023</u> An ordinance of the Lafayette City Council amending the FY 22/23 operating and capital budgets of the Lafayette City-Parish Consolidated Government by increasing anticipated revenues in the amount of \$3,685,670 from the Federal Transit Administration (FTA) Section 5307 Urbanized Area Formula Grant and appropriating these funds along with the required match in the amount of \$2,739,845 for use within the Traffic, Roads and Bridges Department, Transit Operations Division. (Traffic, Roads and Bridges)
- 16. <u>CO-116-2023</u> An ordinance of the Lafayette City Council amending the FY 22/23 capital budget of the Lafayette City-Parish Consolidated Government by increasing anticipated revenues in the amount of \$301,153 from the Federal Transit Administration (FTA) Section 5339 Bus and Bus Facilities Grant along with the required match in the amount of \$53,145 for use within the Traffic, Roads and Bridges Department, Transit Operations Division.
