CO-119-2023 An ordinance of the Lafayette City Council amending and re-enacting Chapter 94, Article II, Subsection 94-57(B) of the Lafayette City-Parish Consolidated Government Code of Ordinances to provide the Director of Utilities or the Director of the Communications System Department with the authority to reserve a portion of the capacity of future facilities for a prospective user upon payment of a deposit of the capital recovery fee by the prospective user. (Utilities)
- 20. <u>CO-120-2023</u> An ordinance of the Lafayette City Council amending the FY 22/23 operating & capital budgets of the Lafayette City-Parish Consolidated Government in the amount of \$9,500,000 by adjusting projects in Bond Fund 441 to fund a new City Court & Marshal Complex. (CAO)

- 23. <u>CO-131-2023</u> An ordinance of the Lafayette City Council authorizing the Lafayette Mayor-President to execute a Cooperative Endeavor Agreement between Lafayette City-Parish Consolidated Government and the National Railroad Passenger Corporation ("AMTRAK"). (Legal)
- 24. <u>CO-132-2023</u> An ordinance of the Lafayette City Council amending the FY 22/23 operating budget and adjusting manning tables of the Lafayette City-Parish Consolidated Government by adjusting the hourly rate of one (1) Marshal's Executive Secretary position within the Lafayette City Marshal's Office. (City Marshal)
- 25. <u>CO-133-2023</u> An ordinance of the Lafayette City Council amending the FY 22/23 operating budget of the Lafayette City-Parish Consolidated Government by increasing revenues in the amount of \$36,204 received from the U.S. Department of Justice for a 2022 Edward Byrne Justice Assistance Grant (JAG), and appropriating within the Lafayette Police Department. (Police)

CO-134-2023 An ordinance of the Lafayette City Council amending the FY 22/23 capital budget of the Lafayette City-Parish Consolidated Government by transferring \$200,000 from the RPL Fire Station #3 and \$250,000 from the Fire Station #5 Projects to the Station 2-Renovations Project within the Lafayette Fire Department for additional funding needed. (Fire)
- 27. <u>CO-135-2023</u> An ordinance of the Lafayette City Council authorizing the Lafayette Mayor-President to execute Amendment No. 3 to the Electric Service Agreement by and between the Lafayette City-Parish Consolidated Government and Stuller, Inc. (Utilities)
- 28. <u>CO-136-2023</u> An ordinance of the Lafayette City Council amending the Lafayette Development Code and the official map of the City of Lafayette, providing for the de-annexation of land within the corporate limits of the City of Lafayette, Louisiana, located generally southwesterly of the Eastbound I-10 @ Ambassador Caffery Parkway off ramp, north of the Estate of Maurice Pellessier Plot 5 located at 2222 West Willow Street and east of the Estate of Maurice Pellessier Plots 3 and 4 located on the south side of I-10 (District 1).
