- 18. <u>CO-146-2023</u> An ordinance of the Lafayette City Council amending the Lafayette Development Code so as to reclassify the property of Case No. 2023-24-REZ 300 Pershing Avenue and 228 Marne Street Rezoning, located generally north of East Foch Street, east of Marne Street, and south of Pershing Avenue; being rezoned from RS-1 (Residential Single-Family) to MN-1 (Mixed-Use Neighborhood). - <u>CO-147-2023</u> An ordinance of the Lafayette City Council approving a Conditional Use Permit to allow a convenience store (with gasoline sales) in a CM-1 (Commercial Mixed) zoning district, Case No. 2023-5-CUP 3014 Kaliste Saloom Road CUP (Conditional Use Permit), located generally north of Kaliste Saloom Road, east of Claremont Circle, and south of Lakeside Drive.
