#### **VETOED ORDINANCE**

The Lafayette Mayor-President on Thursday, September 28, 2023, returned Parish Ordinance No. PO-053-2023 vetoed and has provided a statement of explanation which has been published in the Official Journal on Wednesday, October 4, 2023.

In accordance with Section 2-13(C) of the Lafayette City-Parish Consolidated Government Home Rule Charter, vetoed ordinances shall be submitted to the Lafayette Parish Council and the Lafayette City Council no later than the next regular meeting held after publication of veto statement.

Accordingly, <u>Parish Ordinance No. PO-053-2023</u>, has been submitted for Council reconsideration:

8. <u>PO-053-2023</u> An ordinance of the Lafayette Parish Council setting forth and designating the ad valorem tax millage rates and imposing taxes on all property subject to ad valorem taxation in the Parish of Lafayette and authorizing the assessor and tax collector for the Parish of Lafayette to assess and collect property taxes for 2023. (Finance)
