SECTION 1: All of the aforedescribed "Whereas" clauses are adopted as part of this resolution.

SECTION 2: The Lafayette City Council and the Lafayette Parish Council do hereby approve the appointment of Patrick S. Ottinger as Director of the Legal Department and as Lafayette City-Parish Attorney.

Ottinger of the law firm of Ottinger Hebert, L.L.C., is in accordance with the provisions of Section 4-03 of the Lafayette City-Parish Consolidated Government Home Rule Charter; the pertinent provisions of the Louisiana Code of Governmental Ethics (including but not limited to La. R.S. 42:1111-13), and the pronouncements of the Louisiana Board of Ethics in Advisory Opinions rendered under Docket No. 2000-358.
