- 14. <u>CO-040-2024</u> An ordinance of the Lafayette City Council approving a Conditional Use Permit to allow a bar/lounge in a D (Downtown) Zoning District, Case No. 2024-9-REZ 537 Jefferson Street CUP (Conditional Use Permit), located generally north of East Vermilion Street, east of Jefferson Street, and south of East Congress Street. (CD&P)
- 15. <u>CO-041-2024</u> An ordinance of the Lafayette City Council amending the FY 23/24 capital budget of the Lafayette City-Parish Consolidated Government by transferring \$100,000 from the Handguns-RPL account within the Lafayette Police Department to complete the Mounted Patrol Facility.
