CR-006-2024 A resolution of the Lafayette City Council recognizing the 2024 commemorative observance of 54 years following the forced school integration efforts that displaced students of Paul Breaux High School in the City and Parish of Lafayette and, notably, the triumph of the 1974 graduates impacted by this displacement as they celebrate 50 years since having successfully earned their high school diplomas. - 24. <u>CO-053-2024</u> An ordinance of the Lafayette City Council authorizing entering into an intergovernmental agreement by and between the Lafayette City-Parish Consolidated Government and the City Court of Lafayette for the Judicial Office and Storage Room Access Project and amending the FY 23/24 operating budget of the Lafayette City-Parish Consolidated Government by increasing reimbursement revenues from City Court of Lafayette in the amount of \$200,000 and appropriating within the City Court Fund for said project. (City Court)
- 25. <u>CO-054-2024</u> An ordinance of the Lafayette City Council Lafayette City Council authorizing the Lafayette Mayor-President to acquire immovable property in St. Martin Parish, Louisiana. (Legal)
