- <u>CO-151-2024</u> An eighth supplemental and amending ordinance of the Lafayette City Council supplementing and amending Ordinance No. O-122-2004 adopted on June 29, 2004, to provide with respect to the pledge of revenues to utilities revenue bonds of the City of Lafayette, State of Louisiana, and providing for other matters in connection therewith. (Finance)

(CD&P)
- 21. <u>CO-162-2024</u> An ordinance of the Lafayette City Council amending the Lafayette Development Code so as to reclassify the property of Case No. 2024-31-REZ 824 Rue du Belier Rezoning, located generally north of Nezida Lane, west of Rue du Belier, and south of West Congress Street; being rezoned from CM-1 (Commercial Mixed) to MN-1 (Mixed-Use Neighborhood). - 22. <u>CO-163-2024</u> An ordinance of the Lafayette City Council amending the Lafayette Development Code and the official map of the City of Lafayette, providing for the annexation of additional land into the corporate limits of the City of Lafayette, Louisiana, Case No. 2024-32-REZ 1421 Carmel Drive Annexation, located generally north of Carmel Drive, east of Canal Street, and south of Enduro Drive; and assigning a zoning classification of MN-1 (Mixed-Use neighborhood) (District 5). - 23. <u>CO-164-2024</u> An ordinance of the Lafayette City Council amending the FY 23/24 operating & capital budget of the Lafayette City-Parish Consolidated Government to provide for adjustments of revenue and appropriation estimates. (Finance)
