[CO-049-2026](#) An ordinance of the Lafayette City Council amending the Lafayette Development Code so as to reclassify the property of Case No. 2026-5-REZ 2000 Block South College Road Rezoning, located generally north of South College Road, west of Market Place, and south of Oak Branch; being rezoned from CH (Commercial-Heavy) to RM-1 (Residential Mixed). ANNOUNCEMENT OF VACANCIES ON BOARDS/COMMISSIONS

14. Five (5) vacancies exist on the Transportation Policy Committee (the governing board for the Metropolitan Planning Organization) effective immediately. *Applicants must be either 1) local elected officials, 2) officials of public agencies that administer or operate major modes of transportation in the metropolitan area, including representation by providers of public transportation.*

[CO-060-2026](#) An ordinance of the Lafayette City Council amending the FY 25/26 capital budget of the Lafayette City-Parish Consolidated Government by increasing the use of fund balance in Fund 4610 and Fund 4850 and appropriating within the Capital Improvements Department for the Jeff Blvd Streetscape project. (CID)

[CO-061-2026](#) An ordinance of the Lafayette City Council, acting in their capacity as the governing authority of the City of Lafayette, providing for the abandonment of a certain portion of a ten (10') foot utility easement located on Lot 1 of the ECL International Inc, Lots 1 & 2 Subdivision, located at 1605 West Pinhook Road, and authorizing the Lafayette Mayor-President to execute an act of abandonment in order to effectuate the abandonment on behalf of the City of Lafayette.
