[CO-062-2026](#) An ordinance of the Lafayette City Council providing for the abandonment of a portion of the Hellen Street right-of-way located along the southern boundary of St. Antoine Gardens, thereby permanently terminating public access between Rufus Peck Addition Subdivision and St. Antoine Gardens via Hellen Street and authorizing the Lafayette Mayor-President to execute an Act of Abandonment and Revocation of Dedication. (Elroy Broussard)

[CO-063-2026](#) An ordinance of the Lafayette City Council amending the Lafayette Development Code so as to reclassify the property of Case No. 2026-2-AZON Greig Street & Street of Love Administrative Rezoning, located generally north of East Simcoe Street, west of Dudley Avenue, and south of Mudd Avenue; 306, 310 & 314 Mudd Avenue, 113, 114, 118, 119, 121, 122 & 123 Street of Love and 310 & 311 Greig Street, being rezoned from CH (Commercial-Heavy) and IL (Industrial-Light) to MN-2 (Mixed-Use Neighborhood), and 116 Street of Love being rezoned from CH (Commercial-Heavy) and IL (Industrial-Light) to only CH (Commercial-Heavy). [CO-064-2026](#) An ordinance of the Lafayette City Council amending the Lafayette Development Code so as to reclassify the property of Case No. 2026-14-REZ 6800 Block Johnston Street Rezoning, located generally north of Keeneland Lane, east of Johnston Street, and south of E. Broussard Road; being rezoned from A (Agricultural) to CH (Commercial-Heavy) for the first 250 feet of depth from Johnston Street, and from A (Agricultural) to RS-2 (Residential Single-Family) for the remaining depth of the property. (CD&P)
15. [CO-065-2026](#) An ordinance of the Lafayette City Council amending the FY 25/26 operating budget of the Lafayette City-Parish Consolidated Government to adjust amounts for administrative and general costs to actual. (Finance)
